## Putting God In A Box- A series on how we limit God's work in our lives **Works – part 2** **By:** Patrick Bucksot

In my last article I mentioned toward the end, one last work that we, as the church, must do to fulfill the command of Jesus. In Matthew 28:19, 20, Jesus said *"Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age"*. We must be about the work of making disciples. We don't mind getting people saved and baptized, but struggle with the idea of discipleship. We have to get beyond the idea that having a lot of members in our congregations is the measure of ministry success. Having a lot of people is only a minor part of the success any minister of the Gospel can attain. The most successful ministries are the ones that are changing the lives of the individuals that it touches. In turn, the people whose lives we can change can be equipped to change the lives of others.

Many years ago, I received a vision from the Lord. In this vision I saw a child like you would see in a commercial for humanitarian aid needed for another country. This child was very thin in his body but his stomach was extremely large. It was obvious to me that this child was malnourished so I could not fully grasp what God was revealing to me. When I asked Him about the significance of this child, He told me that He wanted me to see what His church actually looks like. When I asked what He meant, He told me that because of the stomach, this child looked fat but was not fat at all. This child had a distended stomach due to a real lack of nutrition. Medically speaking, the lack of protein in their diets is the main cause of this condition. He

said that His church looks very much like the child He was showing me. The church looks fat, but was suffering from malnutrition. He said that the churches are full of people but void of proper discipleship. He said that the church was really busy at making converts but not disciples. In other words, we are gathering people within the four walls of our buildings but we are not doing much to change them into the image of Christ. When I say "we", I am not singling out any particular church or denomination.

I know that this series has been about different works we do that hinder the move of God in our lives but this particular article deals with the issue of a work that we are failing to accomplish. There are consequences that we as individuals and the church are reaping because we are not properly sowing in to the lives of believers. Without proper discipleship training, many believers are not learning the basic disciplines of following Jesus Christ. Without true structured discipleship being maintained in the church, many believers are left to their own devices to learn the Word of God. When that happens, they will not know where to look for answers or know if the answers are correct. They are left to seeking out sources of truth without the assurances that these places really offer truth. Some of these sources offer ideas about Jesus that seem to be plausible truths but they fall short of the truth. This can be seen throughout the generations of the church. Twenty or thirty years ago we could not have imagined the things that we are seeing allowed in the church today. We are seeing homosexuals being ordained as ministers. A dress code that seems non existent.

**Pastors Corner- “From Defense to Offense”****1 Peter 2:9-10**

*“But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises to Him that took you out of the darkness into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.”*

This is the first of a mini series of teachings on 1 Peter 2:9-10. This month will be a start of showing the power of understanding who we are in Christ and what we can accomplish by the understanding and activating our authority given to us by the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

When I get ready for a ministry trip to the nations I pray for the message the Lord wants for the churches and people of that nation. As I was preparing for the ministry trip to Uganda the Lord placed 1 Peter 2:9-10 on my heart. As I read the scripture I could feel the power of that word for this time. I also started to get excited because I knew that the power of this word for this time in that location would release the glory of God, and it did. The entire Breath of God International Outreach Ministry Team to Uganda experienced the most powerful tangible move of God than any of us has ever experienced before. Multitudes came to know Jesus Christ, thousands were healed and the reports are still coming by calls and emails of testimonies of people getting doctor reports and documentations of healings. Many churches and leaderships were excited and on fire about ministry and what the Lord was doing in their ministries. One report leaped out at me when I read an email after the BOGIO ministry team returned, *“The Laziness of the church has left and the excitement of being what 1 Peter 2:9-10 states the church is pouring out to the streets and villages with signs, wonders and miracles, Revival and Outpouring has surely come!”* What greater report can someone have than to hear the move of God so powerfully?

As I was ministering in a church in Uganda in the mist of the message on 1 Peter 2:9-10 the Lord clearly spoke that this is not just a message for Uganda, Africa. It is a message for our region and all the nations. The power and presence of God became so thick in the church that it was hard for anyone to stand as the Lord opened heaven with signs, wonders and miracles.

**From Defense to Offense**

Please do not be offended by what you are reading but read, research, pray and allow the Lord to give you revelation and insight. This is an exciting time as the Body of Christ is rising up and is going to see the largest harvest of souls and the most signs, wonders and miracles ever in history. This is a time that the Lord is calling out to the Body of Christ to wake up and move out. It is a time to expand the tent stakes (ministries, impact, territories). It is time for the Body of Christ to go from defense to offense. We have been holding ground and trying to defend what we have (church, ministries, and people) and the Lord is calling the Body of Christ to stop defending only but incorporate the offense tactics into our ministries. We build churches or ministries into an area or region then spend more time trying to defend that church or ministry and spend little to no time in outreach and changing lives outside of that church or ministry. Again please do not be offended about the statements because you are in powerful churches and ministries but the Lord has more! He desires to change the atmosphere from the natural to the heavenly supernatural.

The time is here to understand who we are and in that understanding we will walk in the power and authority of heaven. We fight scrimmages (battles) in our lives but do we defeat the enemy or just put off the battle for another time? Then a week, month or year later the battle comes back and we are fighting the same battle as before. It is a time for the Body of Christ to win the battles and tear down the strongholds of the enemy! (2 Corinthians 10:3-6) When we tear down the stronghold we defeat the enemy and take ground and gain territory for the Kingdom of God. When we fight those battles with the weapons given to us by 2 Corinthians 10:3-6 we are victorious. As I

walk through the power of 1 Peter 2: 9 I am only covering an incredibly small part of the meaning of this scripture. It would take hours, day's weeks, months and even years to get to the full meaning of any scripture. But this is the message the Lord has put on my heart for the Body of Christ for this time. I encourage and challenge you to dig deeper in prayer, study, and research, because the Lord will expand even more for you.

### A Chosen Generation

It is so incredible to understand that when you give your life to Jesus Christ you become a part of the chosen generation. I could expand in this statement that could fill books but we will take a look at a few areas of this scripture and I will continue deeper in the next few months.

One of the weapons the enemy uses in the attacks of the Body of Christ is confusion and deception of who we are when we come to salvation by confessing our sins and accepting Jesus Christ as our Lord and the authority that comes with being a Christian. He attacks our understanding and faith and tries to put fear and silence into our lives. (2 Corinthians 4:4) But when we understand who we become and what is expected by the Lord when we come to salvation we see all the promises and destiny given by the Lord is Yes and in Him Amen. We see that all of His promises were designed to come to pass and that He has anointed us and sealed us with the Holy Spirit. (2 Corinthians 1:20-22) We have to capture every thought and put them into obedience of Christ and in that we can punish all disobedience when our obedience is fulfilled. (2 Corinthians 10:5-6).

You are a Chosen Generation. That is something to be excited about. It is not just a ticket into heaven it is an invitation to change the world! It is a promise from the Father to be with you all the time everywhere. It is a guarantee of the inheritance promised to you by the Creator of all things. It is a promise that the weapons of Heaven is at your fingertips when you fight spiritual battles. It is a promise of victory not defeat in your walk with the Lord and the expansion of your destiny. You were chosen by the Creator of all things to go into the world and change the atmosphere by sharing the gospel to every creature and he that believes will see signs, wonders and miracles and every weapon formed against you will not harm you! (Mark 16:15-18). You are chosen generation to bring people out of darkness into His marvelous Light. (Acts 26:18)

And when we understand that the Lord has chosen you then we will understand that if He has chosen you, He will provide for you to accomplish what He has promised. You are a Chosen Generation, *“to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me”*. (Acts 10:18) Being a Chosen generation is not just about your salvation and that is important and incredible but also about you bringing others to the Kingdom of God and that is purpose.

This is a new day for the church (global church) the Lord is calling the Body of Christ to rise up into their Kingdom position to impact the natural world with the Heavenly Explosion of His Glory! The ground is shaking and there is a stirring in the Body to get deeper and deeper into the presence of God. In that intimacy with the Lord there is an outpouring of that love that changes the world.

Next month we will continue with 1 Peter 2:9-10. I only scratched the service on the power of this scripture for the church today. It is His desire to impact this world and advance the territory into Kingdom Territory by defeating the enemy and pulling down the strongholds.

I do believe in “come as you are” but there still needs to be more respect toward the house of God and other believers. I have seen churches throw baby showers for pregnant, unwed teen aged girls. Believers of all ages are reading and flocking to the “Harry Potter” & “Twilight” books and movies. It is the lack of discipleship that has caused countless believers to not understand that God's Word holds truth and understanding in all things. It has caused a lack in maintaining a Biblical world view of society. It has allowed society to indoctrinate believers with its lies, which is forcing several denominations to make non-scriptural decisions concerning their doctrines.

How did we get to the point that sin could be so tolerated in the church? I fully understand that people in church struggle with issues in their lives. Even Paul wrote in Romans 7:14-25 that he had some major struggles between his spirit and his flesh. He was very plain that there was a war raging for control; however, he was resigned to have his spirit man win this war. There is a difference in living a life style of blatant sin and occasionally wrestling with sin. Both are wrong but when we are wrestling hopefully we are also trying to deal with the problem. Paul admitted to his struggles but never proclaimed that he wanted to condone the works of his flesh. We are to be the same way. We cannot condone any sin but we can love people through the sin.

So how did we get here? I had a former pastor preach one time about how we go astray from the foundation of truth. In his illustration, he used a chair standing on the floor. He explained that this chair represented an established truth with its foundations set in four corners. He began to tell us that if we begin to teach a doctrine that only has some truth to it, you begin to deceive the hearers of that word. He then moved the chair by pivoting it on one leg. He proclaimed that we stayed true to the foundation because we were still connected at the corner of the foundation. He then said that if some years go by without checking accuracy of the teaching, the people will not remember that the chair is not on its original foundation. Then if we allow more false teaching to take place we will pivot the chair, on one leg, and maintain that we are still connected to the original foundation at one corner.

He did this several times until the chair was about five feet from where it started. This is what has happened in the church for many years now. We have allowed false teaching to pollute the minds of those who do not know any better and the hearers of this teaching have now become leaders who have been indoctrinated by false teachers. Some, if not most of these teachers, may not have intentionally brought in the false teaching but there was a failure in the leadership to allow the teaching to continue. If a teacher has little understanding about what they are teaching they will only breed less understanding.

Every facet of society has training. Our children go to school to get a good education. At my place of employment we have training for everything you can think of. Our doctors have to be trained in either general medicine or become a specialist. Pilots have to be trained to fly airplanes. We have to be trained and licensed to drive our cars. Everyone gets trained to do something and yet we seem to think that we don't need any training in the Word of God to get ordained in ministry. People are getting ordained over the internet, or some other quick way, and think that they are qualified to handle the responsibilities of the office. The people, who get ordained without the proper training and discipleship, will find themselves in situations where they will cause more harm than good. There is also a difference between being called and being ready for the call. You could say, “God doesn't call the equipped. He equips the called”. That is true, but let's look at a very real situation. The Apostle Paul, when he was Saul, was a man of great authority among the Pharisee's. He had tremendous head knowledge of the Torah and could be counted as an authority of the Scriptures. However, when he had his Damascus road experience, all of that head knowledge meant little because he did not fully understand the grace of God that was explained in the scriptures. He took three years of discipleship training before he ministered the Gospel. He did not rush into ministry just because he could quote the Scriptures. Paul had to submit himself to the authority of God and the men that God had placed over him before he was ready for ministry. Paul had to learn the heart of God in the Scriptures so he could understand the law of Grace.

We can almost take a look at it in this fashion. What would happen if, after parents had their children, they left them to fend for themselves?

The children would not last very long. Children need to receive instruction about learning how to be God fearing, productive citizens. Even if parents do not teach them about the Lord, there are still some things that children need to know about life. The same goes for people who give their hearts to the Lord. There are some basic things that they need to learn in the transition they face from not knowing the Lord to elementary Christian living. From there they will need to learn about victorious living in Christ. Without this discipleship, many new believers in Christ will often times turn back to their old way of life because it is what seems familiar. They may realize that there is a need to do something different with their lives, but without any coaching from churches or strong believers, these new believers may find it easier to live the old life.

How does this tie into the subject of "Works" hindering God's work in our lives? If we are so busy with other things and do not have or make time to teach new believers what it means to be a Christian then we are missing out on the command of Jesus. The life of any believer in Christ is not void of trials because of their new faith in Him. If new believers do not get the proper training from God's Word, they will not have a clear understanding on how to get through the trials. If there is not a clear path to follow, they will easily get lost. It says in Psalm 119:105 that the Word of God is a lamp for our feet and a light for our path. In other words, the Word of God provides all of the necessary light needed to walk out our faith. Whether it is new or seasoned faith, God's Word demonstrates how to walk this path to victory. Without a proper understanding of how to use the light of His Word, any one of us can be tripped up by what is hiding in darkness.

Getting people saved is really the easy part. I do understand that it can be difficult to bring people to the Lord. Sometimes certain barriers need to be broken in an individual before they give their heart to Christ. Then why do I say that getting them saved is the easy part? I equate it with having children. It should be obvious that I don't fully understand what a woman goes through when giving birth so allow me to speak in generalities. When a couple gets married and decides to have children, the easiest thing they can do is bring the child into the world. The real challenge is raising

the child to become a productive member of society. For every positive influence a parent tries to instill into their child, they are bombarded with something opposite that teaches the child to do something negative. Raising children is a challenge for parents today. It is also a challenge for new believers to grow in Christ because most of them have to do it on their own.

What are some of the things that believers need to learn in discipleship training? They need to be taught that God is their source in everything and He will take care of them. This would include training about how their faith will sometimes be tested, stretched and even at the brink of failure but God will provide. They need to be taught who they are in Christ. That God has redeemed them from the curse of the law and calls them His own. They need to learn how to live a life of Holiness and why it is so important to do so. They need to know that they are called the sons and daughters of God, kings and priests of His kingdom. They need to know that God is not a man that He should lie, Numbers 23:19. They should know that they now have power of the Holy Spirit upon them to overcome the enemy of their souls. We have weapons of warfare that enable us to build positive relationships with others while overcoming the influence of the enemy. This list only scratches the surface of what we can learn about God and who we are in His Word, but gives us a start to walking a victorious life in Christ.

One of the best training courses that I have ever taken as a believer is the "In Christ Image" course offered by Pastor Francis Frangipane. The level 1 course does get into some things that may be somewhat difficult for baby Christians to follow, but overall, can provide enough foundation for them to begin a solid growth pattern in Christ. The basic premise behind this course is getting believers of all faith levels in Christ to grow into the very image of Christ. Pastor Frangipane does a great job in revealing the truth of who we are in Christ as shown in the Word of God. As with anything, this course or any discipleship training requires commitment to personal growth. The commitment to true discipleship training doesn't just fall on the believer, but the church as well. The church (body of Christ) needs to make this commitment just as it commits to any outreach ministry.

## Putting God in a Box – WORKS Part 2

Whatever program or discipleship training that a church offers, the leadership of that church must check its teachings with the Word of God. They also need to be committed to keep this training available to all levels of believers. The Word of God has to be the foundation of ALL truth. We cannot promote our denominational doctrines above the Word of God. We have to promote the Word of God within any program, whether it is discipleship training, outreach ministry, mission's ministry or music ministry. This is our foundation, our truth and the path in which all believers must learn and follow toward God. Other than prayer, real discipleship is the only thing that we can do to steer the church in the right direction. It is the only way for the body of Christ to fully understand God's Word and effectively use it to overcome the enemy.

I will close with this. Matthew 28:19, 20, Jesus said "*Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age*".
