## The Weapons of Our Warfare- A series on our spiritual weapons -

**JOY** Bv: Patrick Bucksot

**2 Cor. 10:3 & 4.**

*For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: For the weapons of our warfare [are] not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;*

When God created us in his own image, He had in mind a created being that would exemplify all of heaven and who He is. He wanted us to be a human example of Himself. With that said, we obviously can't go creating animals, planets and other living things with our words. God is the only one that can create life and set all things in order. We were created in His image by having a body, soul and spirit. We are a three part being just as God is a three part but one equal God. Where things fell apart for us was in the Garden of Eden. Adam and Eve were tricked into believing that a moment of happiness would replace the joy of Gods' presence. We fight these same battles today.

There is a great deal of confusion about the difference between happiness and joy. We also have the same reality checks that Adam had when we substitute a temporary fix of happiness in the place of joy. There is one major difference between happiness and joy. If you don't finish reading this article please have this understanding. **Things that make us happy have strings attached to them.** Here is an example of what I am talking about. If you were to buy a new flat screen TV, you would probably be fairly happy. After getting the TV home, you will have to have some sort of cable programming to get the most out of your purchase. Once you have the TV and the cable

programming, you will have to pay the monthly expense of the cable. Now you need a job that will cover that expense. In order to get to your job, you will have to get a car. You will probably have to get a loan to pay for the car so you try to work extra hours for the extra income. All of the extra hours at work minimize the time that you get to watch the TV you just bought. The moment of happiness had so many strings attached that it eventually became a web of deception. The same web that ensnared Adam and Eve.

Joy on the other hand can be explained in this way. It only comes from God. That pretty much settles the debate but I will continue with my explanation. Joy does not have any strings attached. Since God is the perfect gentleman, He will not infringe His will over yours. However, He does have a plan for you. He has promised His goodness over you and He will not forget those promises. True joy is embodied in the act of service. Don't make a mistake in thinking that works bring us joy. It is not by works, it is by service. There is a difference. Works go after the praise of men and service seeks no reward. When we act with a servant's heart, the joy comes when we are not looking for a return on the investment.

When someone has a works mentality, they want an immediate reward. A person that has a servant's heart understands that his reward may not come immediately but realize that being a blessing to others IS an immediate reward.

## Pastors Corner- A word from Pastor Ron – “*Arise & Shine*”

### Isaiah 60:1-2

*“Arise and Shine for Your light has come! And the Glory of the Lord is risen upon you. For behold the darkness shall cover the earth. And deep darkness the people; But the Lord will arise over you and His glory will be seen upon you.”*

I can see the darkness starting to cover the earth more and more, nation by nation, community by community. And if we shake the sleep out of our spiritual eyes we can see the deep darkness falling on the people. We are under one of the most vicious and destructive attacks on the Body of Christ than has been visible in the last several hundred years. Don't misunderstand me the people of God have been under attack since Adam & Eve. Matter fact in Genesis 1:28, when the Lord told Adam to “subdue it”, He was giving Adam his mission orders. So the Word of God and the people of God have been under attack. The enemy has tried to confuse and blind the people of God to cripple them into submission and acceptance of the circumstances and situations before them. Spiritual warfare has been here from the time of the Garden of Eden.

When I was in the Marine Corps, we were concerned with communism overtaking the world. I was sitting in a briefing where they instructor had a map of the world and he wanted to show us the amount of communism had spread. When he had laid a red cover that represented all the communist pockets and areas covering the globe; I was really overcome by the amount of areas that covered by red.

Now if we were to do the same with the darkness and the deep darkness it would blow us away! I remember as a young teenager watching a movie called “The Blob”. It was about this black goo that consumed everything in its path. The plot of the movie was this; the black blob kept moving into different areas and consuming people and every living thing in its path. Until two teenagers decided “enough is enough” and found the weakness of the blob (cold) and used that to destroy it.

*“For behold the darkness shall cover the earth and the deep darkness the people.”* We, the Body of Christ, are at a global cross road. We are at a point that we have to make one of two choices. The Body of Christ can run and act like the darkness will go away, which will allow the darkness to consume everything. Or we can say “enough is enough” and find out what kills the darkness and deep darkness. My friends, only the Word of God and God's people applying it can destroy this darkness!

*“Arise and Shine for Your light has come! And the Glory of Lord is risen upon you.....But the Lord will arise over you and His Glory will be seen upon you.”* I love this scripture! It tells me three things: **1)** I don't have to form my own weapons, **2)** I do not have to form my own tactic's, and **3)** I don't have to build my own strength,

because the Lord will provide all of them with His awesome Presence. We have an awesome part in this master plan to bring the Light of God into the dark places of the world.

Oral Roberts was asked a question, “Why does the Lord use you to heal people?” Oral Roberts' response was simple, “Because I have fallen in love with the sick!” Then he was asked, “What if God does not heal them?” Oral Roberts again responded with a laugh, “He has to because I don't have a plan B!” These two answers are the keys into tapping into the heart of God. Have we fallen in love with the sick and lost? And, do we simply believe because we have no plan B?

I am feeling deep in my spirit that the Lord is launching Breath of God International Outreach Church into a new place and we are going to start seeing incredible signs and wonders. Let's make this the most powerful November in history and reach incredible amounts of people for Christ! Keep making Jesus Famous!

## Ministry Spotlight – THE MINISTRY WITHIN YOU!

To date I have highlighted many different ministries that either involve Breath of God or a ministry of someone that attends BOGIO. What I wanted to focus on this month is something that affects us all. As believers, we all have, or have had issues of doubt. We all wonder what our purpose is serving the Lord. We all probably ask the question, "What is my calling?" Well, we do have a calling on our lives. God does have a purpose for each one of us. Each one of us has an anointing given to us by God for the purpose of bringing glory to our Father and expanding His kingdom.

You may be thinking that you don't have a calling. You probably doubt that God could and would actually use you to minister on behalf of Him. My friends, you might want to look at His word. I hate to say this (well, not really) but Gods' word is full of examples of how He has called us into the ministry. Believe me; I would not have believed it either when I was first saved. I could not have imagined being in any kind of ministry. I never had a long laundry list of awful sins to get rid of, but still had enough to warrant my ticket to hell. I also have lapses of confidence about being used by the Father. But believe it or not, God still desires to use us for His glory.

The first tool that you have in ministry belongs to no one else but you. It is your testimony. It may be very similar to the testimony of others but it is singularly yours. Your spouse or friends can share in your testimony, but they still only have their own testimony to give. What does all of this mean? When God does something for you and you see victory in your life, this is a testimony. Allow me to interject this point; When God has brought you through something, you may not see the immediate victory, but the victory in Him will be made manifest. You may not feel like you have overcome, but look around to see how God is working in you. In **John chapter 4**, Jesus changed the life of the Samaritan woman. After a short time with Jesus, she was compelled to back to her town to share her testimony. Verse 39 states: *And many of the Samaritans of that city believed in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all that I ever did."* The Samaritan woman did not have a theology degree or years of ministry experience, but she did have her testimony. It was enough to convince people to believe in the one named Jesus. **1 Peter 3:15 says**; *But sanctify the Lord in your hearts, and always be ready to give an answer to*

*anyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you...* In other words, be ready to share your testimony because it should show others why you have hope in the Lord.

Another tool that belongs to you is **Hope**. As stated in the verse above, having hope leads us to testify of what God is doing in and through us. Although hope and testimony work together, they are not the same. When we were lost, we had a need to have in inward desire met through many forms of entertainment, possessions, or companionship. There was a vast hole that could not be filled with anything. We found that entertainment never satisfied for very long, possessions did not make us rich (we spent more than we had to get them), and companionship doesn't necessarily make us feel complete. All that we have ever searched for is only found through Jesus Christ. He is our only Hope to fill any void that is in our lives. With our hope centered on Jesus, we should be losing our desire for the things of this world. We have been given everything pertaining to heaven that should be a light unto all men.

**2 Cor. 4:6** says: *For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.* Basically, God has made his light to shine in our hearts so it will shine toward others. He wants, no He commands that we shine his light, our hope to others. Pastor Ron has told us that we don't minister with a full cup but a cup that over flows. God did not just fill us with His light, but made it overflow from us. We can cover it up but I implore you to let it shine. Why? **2 Cor. 4:3,4** says: *But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, (4) whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.* These two verses make verse six (above) hit a little closer to home. If we do not shine the light of Christ, we are hiding it from those who do not know Him. That can be a little intimidating, but it's not meant to be. It should, however, give us more of a desire to share our story. Each one of us has a Hope in Christ. Each one of us should be sharing the hope that is within us because we have a testimony to share. Your testimony may not seem that important, but it may be enough to lead someone to Christ. How awesome would that be?

When we read about anything to do with the Bible, we should always look to Jesus as our ultimate example. Jesus Christ was more than a prophet. He lived exactly how He wants us to live. In all things He displayed Joy. And I can imagine that you are thinking about the time He turned the money changers tables over. You are correct in thinking that He displayed anger. He did, but I will say that He displayed Joy toward His Father. It was the Joy of His Father that caused Him to set things right in the temple. As in all things though, He was lead by the Holy Spirit. Even Jesus would have refrained in the temple if the Holy Spirit had told him.

In **John Chapter 15**, Jesus is explaining who He is in the Father and who we are in Him. **Vs 10:** *If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. (11): "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and [that] your joy may be full.* If we want to live a life of Joy, His Joy, we are to keep His commandments. That sounds pretty easy doesn't it? Well, let's see what **verse 12** says: *This is My commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.* Ouch! If you will remember, the two greatest commandments are these: *"You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind," and 'your neighbor as yourself.'* – **Luke 10:27** If we live the law of love, as He commanded, His Joy will remain in us and our joy (which comes from Jesus) will be full. With Jesus being our example, He never wavered in His love toward Judas. If we were in his position and knowing that Judas would betray us, we would not have washed his feet.

The Lord showed me something about personal relationships many years ago. He said, "Your relationship with another person depends only on you." What He meant was this; It should not matter how another person treats me for me to show them love or treat them well. If we can get beyond the face value of someone's treatment of us, we will have Joy in the Lord. We will be fulfilling the scripture, *"The Joy of the Lord is our strength."* **Neh. 8:10.** I personally have people in my life that grate on my nerves, and it takes a lot of effort to get beyond my feelings. When I trust God, and rest in His strength, His joy is fulfilled in my life. I can enjoy their company when I submit to God and show them love.

I used to be a person that did not enjoy the company of a lot of people. When Beth and I had groups of people at our house, I would end up hiding in our room. Something would irritate me, I would hide, and she had to cover for me. I was a person who did not have a lot of joy in my life. It has only been in the last couple of years that I have had a release. I have been relying on God to help me show love toward others and I have had my joy made full. I feel like a person that is being completed in Christ.

When we operate with joy in our lives, we are disrupting the work of our enemy, the devil. His greatest desire is to steal, kill and destroy everything positive in our lives. He wants us angry, unhappy and dissolved of any hope. When we have joy in our lives, we can put those things to rest. It does not mean that we are without our personal struggles. It is, however, as if we are letting our weaknesses rest on the strength of the Lord. With the joy of the Father in our hearts, love comes easier and our faith seems stronger.

It is hard to imagine how horrible the cross was for Jesus to endure. Who can accurately give a descriptive account of the events surrounding that day. Mel Gibson's movie, "The Passion" is probably the closest to giving a visual reference, but it still probably fell short of the truth. But when I read Heb. 12:2, I am in awe that Jesus saw his joy beyond the cross. The scripture states: *looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.* I believe that Jesus could endure the cross because of the joy in He would have in welcoming his bride into his glory. His sorrow and agony was a fleeting moment compared to eternity with his bride.

Please remember that we can be happy and be without joy. If we try to fill our lives with stuff, we will only have momentary lapses of happiness stuffed with large quantities of being unfulfilled. If we become servants of the Lord and begin walking in our calling, we will have our joy made complete in Him. Our first calling is to love God and the second is to love others. Perfect joy is made complete with love. Perfect love is made complete when we walk with a servant's heart. Our faith in God works by the love of Christ emanating from our hearts. Walk in love and live in joy.
