**Putting God In A Box-** A series on how we limit God's work in our lives

**Works – part 3** **By:** Patrick Bucksot

I know that this makes three newsletters in a row that I have written about works, but it is one of the main wrestling points of our Christian walk. We seem to get hung up on the idea that we have to, or even think that we can earn God's favor, and in that, work for the praise of men. It seems to be that if we do not get recognized for our efforts, we are a failure to the Lord and a ministry. Before I go any further, let me say that I have ridden this roller coaster before and have enabled the enemy of my soul to remove me from my calling. Working without affirmation, when it is so desired, can leave us feeling as if we have wasted our time. Believe me, there is nothing worse than wasting your time when performing a task. Yet, there are times that we need to do things, even if we cannot tell their effectiveness for the kingdom of God.

I am reminded of the movie, The Karate Kid, and either version will apply to my example. For my example though, I will use the original characters since it dates to my teenaged years. When Daniel began his training under Miyagi, he became confused about the training methods and did not see how they applied to Karate. Miyagi had Daniel wash his car(s) with the infamous, "Wax on-Wax off" method. Daniel was instructed to paint Miyagi's fence with purposeful up and down strokes. When Daniel wanted to hit something, Miyagi had him doing chores. After many days or weeks of "working" for Miyagi, he had finally reached his limit and confronted his teacher. Miyagi then showed Daniel why he was washing cars and painting fences

instead of fighting. Miyagi attacked Daniel and gave him instructions to wax on and wax off, and paint the fence. Much to Daniels amazement, he was able to fend off his attacker. Miyagi was not teaching Daniel how to be a painter or a car detailer; he was teaching him discipline when his work did not make sense. He was teaching Daniel to trust that the instruction given to him, although it seemed stupid and unnecessary, was of great benefit in time of the battle.

God has called each one of us to work for Him with a calling and a purpose to glorify Him. There are times that His instructions lead us down roads that do not make sense, but we have to trust that He is taking us to higher levels in Him. Since we are limited to spiritual short sightedness it is hard for us to fully understand why God has us do something or go through something. There are times that we have to go through the hard places because they break things off that cannot go where He is taking us. Those things that need broken from us will ultimately hinder the work that God is preparing for us if they remain unchecked. What do I mean? When Joseph received the first vision that his family would bow down to him, neither he, nor his family understood what it meant. He had a slightly inflated ego and his family was ready to deflate that ego. God took Joseph though some places that made him ready to serve in his calling. After God had completed His work in Joseph, he was fully prepared to lead the nation of Egypt and his family through the famine.

## Pastors Corner

### From Defense to Offense Part 2 “Royal Priesthood” 1 Peter 2:9-10

*“But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises to Him that took you out of the darkness into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.”*

This is the second of a mini series of teachings on 1 Peter 2:9-10. This month will be a start of showing the power of understanding what being a Royal Priesthood truly is and what we can accomplish by the understanding and activating our authority given to us by the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

When I get ready for a ministry trip to the nations I pray for the message the Lord wants for the churches and people of that nation. As I was preparing for the ministry trip to Uganda the Lord placed 1 Peter 2:9-10 on my heart. As I read the scripture I could feel the power of that word for this time. I also started to get excited because I knew that the power of this word for this time in that location would release the glory of God, and it did. The entire Breath of God International Outreach Ministry Team to Uganda experienced the most powerful tangible move of God than any of us has ever experienced before. Multitudes came to know Jesus Christ, thousands were healed and the reports are still coming by calls and emails of testimonies of people getting doctor reports and documentations of healings. Many churches and leaderships were excited and on fire about ministry and what the Lord was doing in their ministries. One report leaped out at me when I read an email after the BOGIO ministry team returned, *“The Laziness of the church has left and the excitement of being what 1 Peter 2:9-10 states the church is pouring out to the streets and villages with signs, wonders and miracles, Revival and Outpouring has surely come!”* What greater report can someone have than to hear the move of God so powerfully?

As I was ministering in a church in Uganda in the mist of the message on 1 Peter 2:9-10 the Lord clearly spoke that this is not just a message for Uganda, Africa. It is a message for our region and all the nations. The power and presence of God became so thick in the church that it was hard for anyone to stand as the Lord opened heaven with signs, wonders and miracles.

#### Chosen Generation

Last month I covered the importance of knowing who we are when we give our lives to Christ. I showed how misunderstandings and misleading’s given by the enemy as he guides us into a path of sitting around and accomplishing very little. But the first step into moving in a deeper walk with the Lord is to understand who you are in the Lord!

#### Royal Priesthood

This month we are going to the next part of 1 Peter 2:9, the Royal Priesthood. This is the destiny of every believer, to walk as a Royal Priesthood for the Lord.

#### Royal

What is the meaning of Royal? In the Encarta Dictionary it states that Royal means;

1. relating to, belonging to, or consisting of a king, queen, or other member of a monarch's family
2. a monarch, or a member of a monarch's family, especially his or her immediate family

#### Priesthood

What is the meaning of Priesthood? In the Encarta Dictionary it states that Royal means;

1. **The Priest’s position** -the official role, position, or office of a priest
2. **The Priest as group** - the priests of a particular religion, considered as a group

#### It Starts with You

It has a starting place and that is in your own life. We are called over and over again to be living a life of holiness for the Lord. To change the things in our lives that hold us back from running freely

with the Lord. If we all take a moment and look into our own lives, pray for the Lord to reveal to us what in us is holding us back He will show you. We have the tendency to not ask, look away, or justify the things holding us back from walking a more holy life for Christ. Our flesh does not want to give in to the submission to the Holy Spirit. I have good news for you. You have the ability to put your flesh into submission this very moment. You have the ability to take control of your life no matter how long you have been in whatever you're walking in and take control of your flesh and kick it out. Think about if you have something in your house that smells terrible. Every time you are in the house you smell that bad odor. You have two choices. Seek out what is causing the bad odor, remove it and clean where it was or you can leave it hoping someday it will go away. Our lives are like that to the Lord. As long as we have our flesh in control and not the Spirit of God in control our flesh stinks of sin. But if we surrender those things to the Lord we become a sweet smelling aroma, the fragrance of Christ among those being saved and among those who are perishing. (2 Cor. 2:14-17).

To walk as a Royal Priest of Heaven we have to become as a Royal Priesthood of Heaven. We are to walk in such a way that it brings people into a desire to become like Christ. We are being called to go back and research the early church and what was their model designed by the Holy Spirit then we as the Body can understand the plan of the Lord for the church today! In the early church it was totally guided by the Holy Spirit not flesh.

Under the power and direction of the Holy Spirit the church grew in numbers, and the sounds of the new church was heard throughout the city. Along with these new sounds came new power – power to lead people to be saved, to deliver, to heal, and to serve. Their meetings were filled with Joy and enthusiasm as they worshiped the Lord and served one another, and the passion of their love for one another was the envy of the world. In addition, signs and wonders, miracles, and supernatural manifestations were dynamic characteristics of the young church! The presence of the Holy Spirit and the preaching of the Word gave legitimacy to the church.

This is how we today are to walk in a Royal Priesthood for Christ. You may say but, that was then and this is 2011 and things have changed. Your right things have changed and the Lord is bringing back the purpose and destiny of the believer with Holy Spirit Power. The enemy has tried hard to quince the power of the Holy Spirit in the Body of Christ, but the destiny of the Lord is greater than the attacks of the enemy! He is calling the Body of Christ to understand they are a Chosen Generation with a mission to walk as Royal Priest for the Kingdom of Heaven. You are to walk as examples of how to walk in holiness. Not by what you say but by who you are! Your lifestyle speaks volumes more than anything you can say. When you are striving for the Kingdom people can see your lifestyle and even in ridicule toward your kingdom decisions they envy your boldness for Christ.

Walking in Royal Priesthood (holiness) is not easy. It was never designed to be easy. It is something we do because we are willing to do whatever it takes to please the Father. The enemy tries to make you believe that it is impossible but, the Lord promises it is possible. The enemy is a liar (John 8:44), the Father can only speak the truth. The one that holds you back from stepping into a deeper incredible impacting walk with the Lord is you. When you take control and say that you are not going to walk in what is holding you back you have become victorious! You have already stepped into your victory! Now take the remaining steps with Joy and expectations.

Walking as a Royal Priesthood for the Kingdom of God is so awesome! Because when you chose to step into your position you begin to see the things designed for your life from God falling into place and things in your life are changed. Your relationship with the Lord becomes deeper and more intimate. Your priorities are put into place and things just seem to flow easier. When attacks come, and they will come, you walk through the battlefield victorious and lives are changed around you. When we come to an understanding, that the Lord does not want us to struggle our entire lives trying to figure out how to get ourselves out of trouble but, to walk in a way that leads others out of trouble we start walking in the Royal Priest position.

### You are a Royal Priesthood

You are the immediate member of the Kings of Kings Family and that makes you Royalty. When you gave your life to Jesus Christ you gave up your roots to this world and became a citizen of Heaven, A son / daughter of the King. You became Royalty of Heaven. (Philippians 3:20; Ephesians 2:19-22) And in that royalty you become a priest to the world. To bring people to Christ and help the Body of Christ to walk in an example and disciple, train, encourage, buildup, show compassion to, equip and send out into the world to become Royal Priest's for the Kingdom.

What an honor the Lord has placed on all believers. Remember that it is not an easy walk but an achievable walk. The Lord has designed you to be victorious so walk in victory!

## Putting God In A Box- A series on how we try to limit God's work in our lives

I remember the testimony of Rush Limbaugh when he was the director of public relations with the Kansas City Royals baseball team. There was a time when he thought that he was “the man”. He believed that he was the reason why the fans filled the stadium during each game. Then the epiphany hit him right between the eyes. As he stood on the pitcher's mound preparing to introduce the individual who was going to throw the first pitch, he looked at all of the fans in the stadium. It was at that moment he realized that none of those people was there to see him. They came to watch the professional baseball players, hired by the team, to represent their beloved city. Once awakened by this truth, he realized that if he did everything he could to make the team more prosperous, he would be prosperous. This epiphany made him understand that his efforts behind the scenes, though unrecognized by the masses, would ultimately bring reward.

How does this apply to our Christian walk and service to the Lord? Not everything that we do for the Lord has to be recognized. Let me make one clarification of the previous statement. God sees everything and will reward us as He see fit in His timing. The problem we have is when we do not see His gratefulness we seek gratefulness from men. Then when we do not receive applause or recognition from men either, we get frustrated and are ready to jump ship. This is a completely unhealthy relationship with the Lord and with others; because we stop trusting the Lord and those He has placed around us. It will lead to failure because we get out of the covering that God desires to place over us, and allow the enemy to seduce us from the place of proper growth in Him.

Let's look at it this way. When a woman gives birth to a child prematurely, the doctors will provide a lot of special attention to this child because it is not ready to go home with its parents. There are times when a child needs to be placed in an incubator, which provides a controlled environment to protect him/her from the outside environment. This time in incubation provides the necessary time for a medical staff to monitor their final development of keratin in the skin. Keratin is the fibrous structural protein

that makes our outer layer of skin. If a new born child does not have the proper development of its skin, it will be susceptible to infection and disease.

Again, how does this apply to us as believers? There are times when we may feel like we are ready to be launched into ministry because we have done a few things for the Lord. However, God may place us in an incubator to give us time to grow in a more controlled environment so we can have proper development of our gifts. The time of incubation will vary from person to person but is still very vital to the growth and development in our calling. It may even get to the point where we want to break down the door that seems to be holding us back, but that can lead to destruction. For example, a chicken that has been cooked but has not finished may taste good, but is prime for someone to become deathly ill. What may look done on the outside can kill someone if it has not become complete on the inside. The same applies to believers and their call to ministry. If we have all the appearance of being finished because we do and say many of the right things, does not equate to us being ready on the inside. It is so easy for us to make others believe that we are done but we need to remember that God does not cook with a microwave. We also need to remember that it is God who calls us and equips us for ministry and it is God who determines the method of our preparation and the timing of our release.

Some people will teach us to never pray for patience because God will make us work out our patience. I firmly believe that we need to have our patience tried because it is in these trials that God molds us into the perfect image of His Son. James 1:4 says, *“But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.”* When our patience gets a work out form the Lord, He is working to complete us. When He completes our patience, He completes us. And, when He completes us, we will be made perfect and lack nothing. When we lack nothing, we have been fully prepared for what He was worked to place in front of us. That includes our calling and ministry. Remember this last thought from Philippians 1:6: *“being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ.”*

## Reaffirmation of Jesus the Christ

Hebrews 11:1 says... "Now FAITH is being sure of what we hope for... and certain of what we do not see.

I interpret that as, "Lord, You don't have to prove it to me for me to believe."

Also... Hebrews 11:6 adds... "And without FAITH it is impossible to please God... because anyone who comes to HIM must believe that HE exists and that HE rewards those who earnestly seek HIM.

This points out two things, We need to be serious about seeking God, and we must have faith.

FAITH that Jesus is who He says He is. In the Gospel of Matthew, Chapter 16, Jesus asked the disciples who the people said He was. They responded with various answers. None of which were correct. Then Jesus asks more directly, "Who do you say that I am?"

Jesus was "new" to the people of that time. He was novel to many. He was charismatic, confrontational, and controversial. Many who heard Him believed, and many turned away.

Yet, the question remains: Who Do You Say That I AM?

We live in a time when the name of Jesus has become commonplace. A time where the Bible – the Living Word of God – can be found almost anywhere. A time when the hearts of men have become desensitized to the Good News... to the Savior.

Locally, we can see billboards about Jesus, about Church. Roadside evangelists holding signs calling people to repentance as they speed by in their cars in a hurry to get to work

with barely a thought for God.

When Jesus told the people, "You must eat My flesh And drink My blood" - the Bible tells us that many turned away and no longer followed Jesus. The message was simply too strong for some.

The rich young ruler turned away when he was called upon to exchange what he had for what could never be taken away.

The people of Jesus' day were not that much different than many today.

"Who do people say Jesus Christ is?" I have heard interviews conducted on the streets where that Question is asked to passers-by. The answers invariably run the same line, "He was a good man," "He was a Holy man," "He was a prophet." Many have awareness - but few have relationship.

Jesus rather pointed question in Matthew 16:15 is two-pronged. Who do You say He is? and who is Jesus in your life?

Let me ask you, is Jesus just Jesus in your life? Now may be the time to ask and answer this timeless question anew.

God Himself builds our faith. Faith in Jesus that He is who He says He is: Master, Lord, Savior, Friend, Son of God.
