## The Weapons of Our Warfare- A series on our spiritual weapons The Name of Jesus

This may seem a bit strange to some readers, but I find it quite "God". As I have taught on the weapons of our warfare, I did not feel that my list was in any particular order. But, as I went through my list, I found that they did end up in a pretty good order of hierarchy. Last month, I stated that the Word of God is probably our most important weapon, but I must say that the weapon I am writing about this month is very much equal to the Word. It is also no accident that this month's weapon is being discussed in the month of December. This weapon makes the enemy shudder with fear. I am talking about the name of Jesus. **Phil. 2:10-11**-*That at the name of Jesus every knee will bow, of things in heaven, and things of the earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the Glory of the Father.* I could stop this article right here and it would be an incredible thing to be reminded of the facts in these verses. Regardless of how bad things can look in our lives, Jesus Christ is Lord! I am

reminded of the man dwelling at the tombs. When Jesus came close to Him, the demons inside the man immediately recognized the authority of Jesus. The name 'Jesus' was a widely used name, but when that name was associated with the King of Kings, it became a name synonymous with power and authority.

The disciple's exercised spiritual authority after the Holy Spirit was given at Pentecost. In Acts chapter five, the Apostles were jailed, beaten and commended to stop teaching in the name of Jesus. The Apostles told the council that they should obey God rather than man. After being beaten, they continued to teach Jesus to the multitude. The Apostles recognized that their works for God only worked through the name of Jesus. They understood that they had no power in themselves other than the name of Jesus. It is by His name and anointing that we operate. It is true that many false teachers perform signs and wonders in His name, but the Word clearly states that God must know the

person using Jesus' name. Matt. 7:22,23 states: *Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'* We, God's church, have been given a great responsibility to do His work in the earth, but even a greater responsibility to use the name of Jesus as the very authority of what we do for Him. The entire Word of God is centered on the Name of Jesus. Everything we do must also be centered on the name of Jesus. Acts 17:28 says: *for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, 'For we are also His offspring.'* The very God that breathed life into Adam had breathed His Spirit into us so that we could and still can do those "Greater Works" that Jesus spoke about in John 14:12. These greater works must be done only in the NAME OF JESUS!

*For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. -Luke 2:11*
