## **The Weapons of Our Warfare- A series on our spiritual weapons -**

**Goodness** By: Patrick Bucksot

In recent months I have been discussing the weapons of our warfare that are contained in **Galatians 5:21, 22** – the Fruit of the Spirit. As I have read this passage over the years, I have often stumbled over the apparent repetition that it contains. I have been confused about kindness and goodness being two separate items, until recently. While in prayer about this article, I sought the Lord for revelation about the simple word “Goodness”. Or is it really all that simple.

We have all heard the phrase “God is Good”, and I would think that most of us struggle with minimizing God to just being good. I still have a hard time saying that He is good when I feel in my heart that He is the epitome of all that is excellent and perfect. How can God just be good? Jesus said in **Matt. 19:17**, *“Why do you call me good? No one is good but one and that is God.”* Even Jesus used the term good to describe God and we know that Jesus never minced his words. He always meant exactly what he said. I believe that if we take a deeper look at ‘goodness’, we might appreciate how good God really is.

Goodness by definition can mean several things and as I list them you will probably begin to get the true understanding. Here we go: *The state of being good; moral excellence; virtue; excellence of quality; the best part of anything; integrity; honesty; uprightness.*

Wow, I think that these describe God in a very real and personal way. Now I know that these alone do not complete a true picture of God but they give us a pretty good start. How

does this apply to us as His children though? I believe that goodness is part of the foundation that forms us into the image of God.

If goodness is ‘the state of being good’, then I would say that it must be in the very core of who we are. It must override everything that tries to make us do the wrong things. Without goodness being at the forefront of all that we do, we will not display kindness, gentleness, patience, love, joy, longsuffering and self control. I am not trying to say that goodness is greater than the other fruit of the spirit, but I don’t see us fulfilling God’s word without it being deep within us.

We display kindness toward others because of goodness. You might be mentally picturing all of the kind people you know and believe that they are good people. They may be, but goodness is not a part time job. Goodness, if it is as deep as we need it to be, is a 24/7 activity. Those that are lost but still display acts of goodness will most often be doing them publicly. We don’t know what they do behind closed doors. I am not trying to judge anyone, but let me make this point; we are not justified by our works but by our faith in Jesus Christ. - **Gal. 2:16** We display goodness because of our faith in Jesus, not to gain favor.

Goodness will push us to moral excellence. **Prov. 22:1** states - *A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches.* It used to be that men could make a deal with only a hand shake. A man was counted on by his word.

## Pastors Corner- A word from Pastor Ron – “Creation Eagerly Awaits”

*“For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God.”*

### **Romans 8:19**

Throughout time the Lord has opened up heaven and poured out His awesome Glory and Love to allow His creation to see His Face. The Reformation was about Salvation through faith alone. The Revivals of Wesley, Whitfield and Finney were definitely about salvation, but they added holiness. That was the focus of that time. Only Thirteen thousand attended the Azusa Street Revival for the 3 ½ years. And most of them were Christian leaders from the US and around the world. (Taken from Spread the Fire, Toronto Airport Christian Fellowship, Issue 5-2001, page 8 paragraph 7&8) Then there was the Lakeland, Florida Outpouring in 2009 where technology of the world was used and people were being healed and churches set on fire by God from watching it on TV, Internet, God TV and even watching prerecorded services. Creation Eagerly Waits.

For the last three years we have been eagerly seeking the Outpouring of the Lord! There has been Visions of a Holy Tsunami sweeping this region. We have felt this awesome wave of the Lord’s Glory sweeping this region. There has been a sense of expectation. There have been prophecies over and over again about a radical repentance, seriousness of getting our lives right in the eyes of God. We were being pulled into getting deeper into our relationship with the Lord. Creation Eagerly Waits.

January 2009 the Lord prepared me that there would be a Corporate Fast coming to BOGIO and to get prepared for the Timing of the Lord. That came January 24, 2010. The BOGIO Church launched a 21 day Daniel Fast. The excitement was getting stronger and expectations were growing.

We at Breath of God International Outreach Church (BOGIO) have been experiencing something that is so sweet, so wonderful, so God. There is an outpouring that has come to BOGIO that is so awesome and in a new way. On February 4<sup>th</sup> as I was in my office the Lord very clearly said, Outpouring is coming. That evening service was where the Outpouring started. This Outpouring is not like any I have ever studied or experienced.

This Outpouring is not about works it is about intimacy. On Sunday February 14, 2010, the end of the 21 day corporate fast there was a snow storm that left 7 inches of snow. After praying and seeking the Lord we decided we were going to have

Church. That Sunday Radical repentance fell on the BOGIO Church! For 3 hours the church was radically repenting! This is so awesome because there can’t be an outpouring without radical repentance. Creation Eagerly Waits.

### What’s Next?

*“For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God.”* Romans 8:19

The Lord is seeking for those that will become visible sons / daughters of God. Creation is eagerly waiting for the revealing of the sons / daughters of God. It is not enough to just claim to know God and remain hidden. It is time to become radical and birthing fruit. It is a time to get deeper in our relationship with the Lord. So many Christians try and do Works, stay busy in the name of Christ and accomplishing some achievements but it is at their ability. Please don’t misunderstand what I am saying. Praise the Lord on any and every accomplishment we can do for the Lord. There is more! When we get at the feet of Christ we are being filled to overflowing.

When we read Luke 10:39-42, the story of Mary & Martha worship and serve, we see Jesus explain the importance of just sitting at His feet and soaking up His love, grace, direction, empowerment and by sitting there and spending the time at His feet what we receive cannot be taken away. Jesus very clearly speaks on the importance of spending time just worshiping and soaking in His Presence.

The Church has been programmed to work, work, & work. Praise the Lord for the accomplishments that had been achieved. But there is a way to be more effective. When we take the time to soak (marinate) in the presence of God we become the flavor of God! When we spend the time of marinating in His presence when we go out in evangelism we see the atmosphere change because Creation sees what it has been eagerly awaiting for, the sons /daughters of God operating in the Supernatural instead of the works of good intentions.

What happens when we marinate in the presence of God, when we are the flavor of God? Acts 2:14-47, one message and over 3,000 are saved! Acts 3:1-10, the sick looks into your eyes and see Christ heart and they are healed. Acts 4:23-31 your prayers causes the ground to shake because the Lord shows up and everyone around is filled with the Holy Spirit and speak the Word of God with boldness. Acts 5:12-16 and all that are brought around your airspace are healed because God is with you.

It is time to walk as sons / daughters of God. *For the earnest expectation of the creation eagerly waits for the revealing of the sons of God.* Romans 8: 19 is a scripture being fulfilled today around the world. The Lord is not providing this Outpouring for the attendees of BOGIO alone. That is not the purpose of this Outpouring it is to be spread everywhere we go. When we marinate in His presence where ever we go creation will be drawn to be healed physically, mentally and spiritually. It is time for the Body of Christ to kill fear and rise up faith. Sons & daughters of God live in radical fearless faith.

A man wanted to be found trust worthy when he said something and was the shame of the town if he was found to be a liar. Moral excellence would carry you a long way, and moral corruption would get you run out of town on a rail. Moral excellence is rooted with a deep seed of goodness.

When the woman with the issue of blood touched the hem of Jesus' garment, virtue had gone out of Him. It was a tangible pouring of Himself into her and she was made whole. I know that she was healed by the power of the Holy Spirit and her abundant faith triggered the flow of anointing. I also believe that Jesus ministered so much out of the abundance of heaven, that He radiated the goodness of God that powerfully. There were a lot of people touching Him and if he was that radiant with God, why weren't they touched by His presence? It's very simple, she wanted set free. The rest of them were only going after the star effect. In other words, they wanted to be able to tell others that they got close enough to touch the one who claimed to be Gods' messenger. She went away from there knowing that God touched her. That is a huge difference. We really do the same thing when we go to church. Most people proclaim on Monday, "I went to church yesterday." While some proclaim that, "God moved in a powerful way yesterday and I felt His presence." Sadly they were probably talking about the same church service. We need the virtue of God to pour out from heaven everywhere we are and not just at church. **Proverbs 31** discusses the virtuous woman. I believe that the underlying message within that passage is complete selflessness. Isn't God also selfless with His love toward us? If we let God's goodness emanate from us, as his ushers, shouldn't we become more selfless as well? This will make us look more like Him because we will develop more of a servant's heart.

**Psalm 7:10** says: *My defense is of God, Who saves the upright in heart.* If our hearts are pure in motive and deed, God is our defense. I have often used **John 8:32** to calm people down after being falsely accused. I mean that their motives were questioned by others. The scripture reads; *You shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free.* If you walk with an upright heart you will have a purity that is highly regarded. If questioned about your motives, which God sees from the beginning, and you are upright, God is your defense. Regardless of what others will do or say. When Joseph was tempted by Potiphar's wife, he remained upright in heart. Although he still went to prison, God was his only

defense. Joseph remained upright in heart while in prison and eventually became the second in command of all Egypt. It is necessary that we also remain upright in heart even when things don't look so good because we need God as our defender. When we react to things from a selfish heart, we will have a harder time getting through tough times. Why? Because we have placed ourselves as our own defense attorney, which is a job we cannot fulfill. We will lose the case every time if we try to do it ourselves.

To me, goodness is not just a simple explanation of God and who we should be. I know that God is love but He demonstrates that love out of the goodness of who He is. For us, it has to resonate from every fiber of our being. If we want to reflect His image to a lost and dying world, we need to let God's goodness dictate our every action, thought and deed. We do not need to rely on goodness as a way to check off a list of good things that we do. We need to have our faith grown strong enough that regardless of the circumstances we will choose to do good. We need to do good whether we receive any immediate payback or not. Let's take another look at Joseph. After he interpreted the dreams of the chief butler and the chief baker, he had asked the chief butler to remember him. Joseph spent some more time in prison because the chief butler forgot about him. It wasn't until pharaoh had his own dreams that the butler remembered Joseph. When Joseph was summoned before pharaoh, he was used by God to interpret the dreams. We do not read anywhere about Joseph being angry at the chief butler. Joseph held his peace, allowed the goodness of God to rule in his heart, and a nation was saved. Joseph knew that, just like the accusation of Potiphar's wife, this was not his fight. He knew that God was the one to receive all of the Glory, Honor and Praise. He knew that God is the true and righteous judge.

Do we believe that God will judge righteously over us? Do we believe that God is the lifter of our heads? Do we believe that God knows what our rewards should be? Let's forget about our rewards, let Him worry about when and how to provide the payback, and work for Him as if working for Him is reward enough. Let's allow the goodness of God flow through us so we become like the fragrance of God. We can't be ready to give an account for what God has done if people don't see His goodness flowing. Let's be a vessel full of the good wine!

## Worship By: David Daniels

The word worship brings to mind different things to different people. Some may think of a song, a time or a place while others may think of an attitude or physical position or a combination of all of the above. I like to think of worship as a life style. In Genesis chapter 22 we read the story of Abraham offering up Isaac as a burnt offering at the command of God. In this story I saw how Abraham had a life style of worship. In Genesis 22 the word worship is used for the first time in the Bible. We also see Abraham building an altar; this was not his first but his fourth one that the bible mentions him building. The first three were at places he stopped at; this last one was at a place God had led him to. In Genesis 22:9 the word altar is used for the 7th and 8th time in the Bible. Seven usually represents completion or perfection and 8 represents a new beginning or new birth. This whole story is a prophetic parallel to the complete and perfect sacrifice that God the Father gave us in His son Jesus so we could have a new beginning and new birth. Because Abraham was in covenant with God, his willingness and obedience bond, God to do the same for him. What follows is an acrostic that will hopefully allow you to see worship as a life style and not just a song a time or a place.

**W** - Worth - What is God worth to you? Is he worth your time , treasure, talents and your very best?

**O** - Obey - Will you obey him, immediately?

**R** - Respect - Will you respect His house and leaders?

**S** - Sacrifice - Will you bring him a sacrifice? Will you be a sacrifice?

**H** - Hope - Will you hope in His word?

**I** - Intimate - Will you seek an intimate relationship with Him?

**P** - Peace - Will you rest in His peace?

Read Genesis chapter 22 and see if you can spot how Abraham and Isaac did all of the above in his lifestyle of worship.
