GOD'S GRACE IN TRAGEDY

Editor's note: Normally, this space is for an article that continues the series on "Putting God in a Box". However, this month I feel led by the Lord to share an article that I originally wrote in 1999 for another church newsletter. This is actually a testimony about how Beth & I saw the hand of the Lord bring us through the premature delivery of twin girls on March 25th 1992. I pray that it ministers to each of you in a powerful way. This article has been minimally edited for this newsletter and remains mostly as written in 1999.

If you were to look at me in a general setting, you would never know that tragedy had paid a visit in my life. As a matter of fact, most people have had or will have tragedy, in some form, in their lives. Tragedy in essence is unavoidable, yet we continue on with our lives. What makes most of us able to cope with tragedy and still others crumble at the mere thought of disaster? I have two cases in my life when tragedy struck home; a miscarriage (premature birth) of twin girls and the death of my dad; yet in both of those trials, God allowed me to sail through the troubled waters as if they were calms seas. I will only concentrate on the miscarriage of my twin girls.

The first time that I suffered any real tragedy in my life was when Beth and I went through the miscarriage of our twins. Five and a half months into the pregnancy, Beth began to have complications and had to be hospitalized. At that point, we still were not sure that the pregnancy would end. Our hope was

in God and knew beyond a shadow of doubt that He was in control. We knew that He loved us and had told us to have children. We had originally wanted to wait to have children, but believe that God had directed to proceed with having children shortly after we got married. We had asked for God's blessings when we got married and wanted to only please Him.

Early on the morning of the miscarriage, Beth's water had broken, and the doctors told us that nothing could be done. We never thought for a moment, "Why is this happening to us?" For whatever reason, God had given both of us a peace that surpassed all understanding. Within a matter of hours, the death of our babies would come true. Was it agonizing to wait for the end? Not really, because God had enveloped us with ALL that He is, so we could get through this finality. The biggest trouble for me was watching Beth go through the delivery. All I could do during the delivery was show her my love and support. I was not really hurting for me, but for her. I felt so insignificant to what was happening.

After the delivery, I watched the nurse put the twins, Rachel and Elizabeth, on the warming table. I could tell that the delivery was extremely rough on them because they had purple splotches all over their lifeless bodies. I was concerned that Beth would blame herself for what happened.

Pastors Corner- A word from Pastor Ron – I Want To See Your Glory! John 11:40

“Jesus said to her, “Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?”

This is an interesting and exciting time in the global Body of Christ (church). There is a heavenly shift happening within the global Body of Christ. The Body of Christ is getting hungrier to see the glory of God. There has always been a desire for His glory but there has been something that needs to be in place for that to happen and that is a hunger and passion for His face. Please don't misunderstand me there are incredible things happening in the Body of Christ and has been throughout the barriers of time. But there is a shift that is in place that is for “Today” in the Body of Christ. There is a deep hunger and passion to see His glory at all cost.

This is an exciting and heavy time for the Body of Christ. The Lord is showing up in powerful and mighty ways. At Breath of God International Outreach Church I have been with the Leadership praying and fasting for the Lord to bring us into a new deeper level of anointing. We have been looking and bringing men and woman of God that are in the apostolic ministry of teaching the Body of Christ to move in the gifts. You see it is not just about someone in leadership positions operating in the gifts, it is about bringing the love of the Lord into a tangible existence but the Body of Christ stepping up and going out and operating in their anointing.

We at Breath of God International Outreach Church partnered with The Church @ New Bern and brought Joan Hunter to BOGIO and she not only operated in the gift of healing but spent 22 hours in 4 days teaching the Body of Christ how to operate in healing in the highways, byways, the hedges and marketplaces. In those 22 hours of intense teaching hundreds were healed from sickness of pain in, backs, necks, all over their bodies, cancer, Fibromyalgia, rotator cuffs healed, knees healed, people grew in height, legs grew, arms grew, and many more healings. There are Testimonies after testimonies on how people are taking what they learned to the workspaces, neighborhoods, marketplaces and healings are still happening. We are seeing weekly healings at the midweek and Sunday services at Breath of God International Outreach Church.

The Body of Christ is talking on the phone and telling family members and friends that are sick to place their hands on the areas hurting or where they are sick and they are being healed over the phone. My six year old granddaughter called her Grandmother (Brenda) that she was real sick with headache & fever. Brenda told her to place her hand on her head and to pray the same prayer she prayed and our six year old granddaughter repeated the prayer and was healed! She was great in the morning and even eating at Cracker Barrel the next Afternoon.

Our Breath of God International Outreach Eagles, Children Church leader showed a little boy how to pray over his little sister and she was healed instantly. God is using those that are willing to be used even the children.

This is not about individuals being greater than others it is about ushering in the presence of God and believing and expecting His promises coming to pass.

What we are starting to see is Mark 16:17-18 come alive. It is not about a person or a ministry it is about the Lord! The Presence of God is getting thicker and thicker that even people are getting saved in the fellowship area before services even start. There is a sense of the Father's love that is being poured out into people drawing them closer to His heart!

I was in worship at Breath of God International Outreach Church 7:00 PM on Thursday, January 27th when the Lord showed me a vision of an underground missile silo and there were two keys being turned at the same time, I could see only the hands and keys and I knew the hands was of the Lord and Jesus. Both keys were being turned at the same time and a code was being placed into the key pad at the same time. Then I was above a field almost as if it were a livestock field that would be used for grazing and then the ground shook and it was the doors of many missile silos were being opened. When I looked into the silos the missiles was the Body of Christ ready for launch to predestinated locations!

“Jesus said to her, “Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?””

What does this mean? How does this vision affect me? I will speak prophetically; “The time has arrived for a powerful outpouring of the Glory and Presence of God. It is a time when the outpouring will not be contained in a building or a single location. It will not be by just men or women in leadership or heads of ministries. This outpouring will come by the Body of Christ being sent out in the highways and byways, the hedges and marketplaces. It will not be an outpouring focused on a man or ministry but on the ushering of the presence of the Lord by the Body of Christ. This will be like a rushing river of God breaking out in strategic locations around the world and with each wave of the outpouring it will flood the countryside, streets, neighborhoods, villages, towns & cities. This is the tsunami that has been prophetically spoken of for years. The Body of Christ is being launched to designated locations and ushering the Presence of God and changing the atmosphere in those locations. Praise the Lord!”

Do you want to see the Glory of God?

“Jesus said to her, “Did I not say to you that if you would believe you would see the glory of God?”” John 11:40 The first step is to put fear in its place, under your feet! And reestablish faith in its designated place, your life! Fear keeps you from stepping out and expecting the Lord to do what He has sent you to do. You can overcome fear anytime by taking the step and to focus on His face. You say, “That is too simple, too easy of an answer, you don’t understand. Sure I do, I’ve been there. Just like Peter when he was with the other disciples and the storm was overcoming the boat and death looked unavoidable, fear flooded the boat faster than the water from the sea or storm. All of them were overcome with fear. Then who shows up? Jesus with the solution,” replace fear with faith! Fear was blinding the disciples and they did not even recognize Jesus. But Peter pressed in deeper and put his fear in its place under his feet! How? By redirecting his focus from the fear to the face, the Face of Jesus. As long as we are focused on the fear and failure we will never reach our full potential and destiny. When Peter redirected his focus on His face we was doing the impossible. His faith grew and expectation was established. But something very important must be in place also. How do we continue the momentum? By keeping the focus on the Face of Jesus. This is not an easy two step thing to do. When Elisha asked for a double portion of Elijah’s anointing Elijah said, “you have asked a hard thing.....” 2 Kings 2:10. It is a hard thing to carry on what the Lord wants you to do with the anointing, but you can do it! Are you willing to put fear in its place under your feet and faith in its place in your life? Are you willing to get rid of the things that offend God? That is the hardest thing to do because we love to carry the trash (things that offend God) until it rots. You may say, “What offends God, How will I know something offends God?” I have a simple comment to that statement, “You know what offends God!” We have to ask Him to show us with a heart that is willing to listen and not justify those smelly things.” The number one thing that holds back the potential of what God wants to do is we want to operate in His promises and gifts with the stench of trash that offends God. When you release the garbage it releases the stench also and you move into a more effective productive and powerful move of God!

Do you want to truly see the Glory of God? Start doing the things of God. Do you want to operate in the Power of God? Start seeking and running to the opportunities that God places in front of you. Read Luke 10: 17-20, Mark 16:16-18, Matthew 28:16-20, John 17, Acts 2, Acts 10:38 as marching orders for your life. Make the decision to get closer to the Father’s heart at any cost! Set your time aside no matter how busy you are to spend quality time with the Father. Read scriptures that build your faith and energize your spirit. And “Step out of the Boat!”

As I watched over them, I knew in my spirit that God could and would raise them from the dead if I asked Him, but I did not because I didn't need God to prove himself to me. Despite the circumstances, I knew that God was in control. He later showed me that there would be a greater testimony in my life if I continued to serve Him after these events, rather than if the twins were raised from the dead. It sort of reminds me of the story of when Jesus told the lame man that his sins were forgiven, and eventually told him to take up his bed and walk. I believe that He was showing us that our spirits have a greater need than our bodies, but proved that He took great care for both the spirit and the body.

Trails such as these make us stronger rather than weaker; at least they are supposed to. God wants us to trust Him even if things don't go as planned. The premature delivery and death of our twins does not prove that we were wrong about what God told us (to have children). If you believe that we were wrong, would you also believe that any parent who had a child die in a car accident was wrong for having them? I think not. The fact that I continue trust and serve God eight years later (now 19 years) is the testimony that He desired from me.

I would love to have my twin girls back, but I don't want back bad enough to lose the two children that God has given me since the miscarriage. When I told that to a co-worker, God spoke into my spirit and basically said the same thing. He said, *"I would not take back the death of my own Son, to lose you or anyone else"*. No one will completely understand how that ministered to my heart, but I am sure that it will minister to all that hear the Word from God. He used the miscarriage and my testimonial triumph over the doubt and discouragement to share with me the whole truth of His Gospel. God takes our pain and suffering personal just as if it were His pain and suffering. Why? That is part of Jesus' job at the cross.

God did a wonderful thing in my life during that trial. He allowed me to feel His presence in a way that I had never experienced before. The wonderful presence of God is powerful and unexplainable at the same time. It is something that, if experienced, will change your life. God is still in the business of changing lives and desires for us to experience His presence.

Although we went through this together and held on to one another, Beth's testimony will be different from mine because she had the burden of carrying and delivering the twins. The only thing that would remain similar between our testimonies in the fact that we both suffered a great loss, we both love the Lord, want to serve Him, and use what He did for us to bless others. My hope is that this testimony has blessed you and has given you the courage to go through you next trial.

Looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Heb. 12:2

“Soaking In His Presence” By: Pastor Ron

January 2011 we at Breath of God International Outreach Church (BOGIO) have started Soaking in His Presence. What is Soaking in His Presence? I have felt in my heart for over a year an urgency for 24 hours / 7 days a week prayer (24/7). I continued to ask the Lord how is this going to happen? After praying and fasting we started “Soaking in His Presence” at Breath of God International Outreach Church on Wednesdays. We are opening up the Breath of God International Outreach Church 6:00 AM – 6:00PM for people to come into the church and pray, worship, read the Word. This is open to anyone from any location to come and soak. You do not have to be from BOGIO to be a part of the soaking. You are free to come and go as you feel lead. We are providing soaking music and at times even streaming the International House of Prayer (IHOP) in Kansas City, Mo. So we are linked with them in the exact time they are praying.

We have started this “Soaking in His Presence” as a stepping stone to 24/7 in this region. We are Soaking in His Presence January-March on the Second Wednesday each month, April – June is the Second and Fourth Wednesdays, July – September is the Second, Third and Fourth Wednesday of each month and October – December is every Wednesday. As you can see it is a step into the direction of every Wednesday as a “Soaking in His Presence.”

Overseeing Teams

To have this type of prayer ministry to be effective it takes people to help. Starting in April we will be asking people within the BOGIO Body of Christ to sign up for a 2, 3, or 4 hour slot to be at the church to oversee the Soaking time. This will free up the leadership to minister as needed in off locations of the church. These 2, 3, and 4 hours slots the overseers can be in the sanctuary soaking or in the administration office. This is a Corporate Ministry

Wednesdays only does not fill the other 6 days of the week of the vision I had for 24/7 in this region. Well after praying on how we can do this the Lord has opened two other local churches to take Thursdays and the other Fridays. So by the end of 2011 this region will have Wednesday, Thursday & Friday covered in praying for this region. This is becoming a Corporate Ministry! So exciting! We are standing on the promise that by the end of 2011 we will find 4 more churches that will take a day of the week and have “Soaking in His Presence” that will fulfill the 24/7 prayer in this region. So please join us in prayer that those other churches would step up and take a day of the week and that this vision will be fulfilled before the end of 2011.

Come and be a part of the most powerful time you can spend soaking in the presence of the Lord, where there is wisdom, knowledge, healing, revelation, intimacy with the Lord, passion for the Lord, deeper walk with Him, stronger walk with Him, relax in His arms and experience an open heaven.
