WHEN FAITH TOUCHES THE ANOINTING, IT RELEASES THE POWER OF GOD

The Weapons of Our Warfare- A series on our spiritual weapons - Meekness By: Patrick Bucksot

We have all heard the scripture from the Beatitudes, "*The meek shall inherit the earth.*" It was actually first mentioned in **Psalms 37:11**. In today's society that almost seems unimaginable, but we must remember that God isn't finished yet. Jesus gave us plenty of warnings that tribulation would come and that Christians would be persecuted for their faith. In these times of persecution we are called to count it as a joy in our lives. It is frustrating to watch as those that don't want anything to do with God seem to be blessed beyond measure while believers seem to be scraping by. I am reminded that Jesus said in **Matt. 16:26** – "*For what is a man profited, if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul?*" This is played out in the parable of Lazarus and the rich man.

The rich man seemed to have everything that he wanted in a physical sense. Lazarus, on the other hand, had nothing of his own. He was festered with sores, and dogs would come to lick his wounds. They may have been his only friends. The rich man had to know Lazarus, but only as a lowly beggar without any value. I am sure that the rich man found Lazarus to be a serious nuisance as well. When Lazarus died, he was carried into Abraham's bosom, where he would not be begging any more. The rich man died and was placed into hell. The

apparent status change did not register with the rich man because he had asked Abraham to send Lazarus over to give him something to drink. For the first time in his life, he was full of want and could not be satisfied. What would have happened to the rich man if he had shared his wealth and made provision for his soul?

This parable does not condemn the gathering of wealth. It does, however, want us to see that we are to minister with the things that God has given to us. The more we gain wealth, without first making God the center of what we do with that wealth, the more we will slowly become enslaved by the worldly systems that we are using to gain that wealth. Even if our intentions are good, if God isn't in control of our hearts, we will be working for the world.

How do the meek inherit the earth if the worldly systems seem to be in control? I know that it's hard to see the hand of God a lot of the time, but we must remain focused on Him. If you will remember the article on Praise (July '09), I wrote '*Any kind of praise offering is good, but those which proclaim the majesty of God for no other reason but we are proclaiming His majesty touches the heart of God.*'

Pastors Corner- A word from Pastor Ron – “New Wine in Enlarged New Wineskins”

“Nor do they put new wine into old wineskins, or else the wineskins break, the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But they put new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved” **Matthew 9:17**

“Enlarge the place of your tent, and let them stretch out the curtains of your dwellings; do not spare; lengthen your cords, and strengthen your stakes. For you shall expand to the right and to the left, and your descendants will inherit the nations, And make the desolate cities inhabited.” **Isaiah 54:2-3**

Wow, we at Breath of God International Outreach Church (BOGIO) have so much new happening it can spin you around if you allow it to. There is a rich pouring out of the Lord in the services, people are being healed and set free, worship is getting deeper, people are being empowered and sent out and we are moving into a new building in April. Lots of stuff going on and if we are not careful it can be overwhelming! But then again if we are doing it in our power it would be overwhelming but in the power of God it is awesome!

With all these really awesome things the Lord is doing, I get a call to meet with the staffing of the Airport. Our timing is OK but God’s timing is Awesome! At 10:00 AM March 8th I was told by the airport we have 60 days to find a new location for the church. Immediately I felt this peace of the Holy Spirit come over me in the Airport Manager office and as he apologized for the 60 days notice I was blessed to thank him and the airport staffing for all the blessings they had provided for BOGIO Church in the last year and half. I asked if I could pray for the Airport Manager and his staff. During our prayer I heard the Holy Spirit gently say, *“Have peace the Lord knows what He is doing.”*

In my prayer times I keep hearing this same scripture Matthew 9:17 and Isaiah 54:2-3. The following day I shared with the BOGIO Board and BOGIO Staff that we had 60 days to find a new location for BOGIO Church I received a call the first of several calls with the same message, *“This is a promotion, God is extending your tent cords and stakes”* Kathy

Bunting was walking out of the BOGIO Church one Thursday evening and looked at me and with conviction said, *“Promotion, Promotion, Promotion, God is promoting!”* I was with a pastor praying again on Thursday March 25, 2010 and in our prayer time he spoke a word for the BOGIO Church, he said, *“This is a promotion, God is extending the BOGIO tent cords and stakes.”* I had not told him what others have been calling and telling me was the exact same thing.

This is an exciting time. God is promoting us into a new place of outpouring and growth. This is a time of celebration as we allow the Lord to build new wineskins and expand our tent cords.

This is a time when the Lord wants to pour new wine (His Spirit) upon the body of Christ and we have to be able to receive the new wine (His Spirit) in vessels that can uphold the expansion. Because when the Lord promotes He expands us!

This is important because we so often get to a place where we get comfortable and in that place of being comfortable we start to rely on our abilities or the coattails of past achievements instead of remembering the importance of trusting God for today events.

In order for us to move into the next thing the Lord is doing in us spiritually we have to toss the old wineskins and allow Him to build new wineskins. What am I talking about? So often we hold on to the coattails of what the Lord has done in the past and try and resurrect it into today. We have held onto what the Lord has done in past outpourings or prophetic words and tried to get the Lord to pour out into our old wineskins but the new wine has to expand. We have patched and repaired the old wineskins (ourselves with conditional residence) so many times as soon as the Lord starts pouring into us we leak and feel dry and broken in no time.

What I keep hearing from the Lord is listen for the crack in the dam! Listen for the cracking in the dam that has held back all the Blessings, Glory and Outpouring. It is time for a flashflood of the Glory and power of God! It is a time that the Lord to rip open heaven and pour all the awesome Glory and Power into the Body of Christ

and the Word of God be spread with boldness and power!

We have built the dam stopping the flow of His desires into His creation. When we have restricted or conditioned the will of God in our surroundings we have placed new concrete on the Dam (blockage).

If we are not careful we can become a people of routine. Please don't get offended. In the natural we are trained to come up with a routine and follow that routine to completion. There is an old saying, "Don't reinvent the wheel", meaning if it is not broke don't fix it. That is why people fall into the trap of being comfortable. Don't shake the cart if it is running smooth. But the church (Global) has been in a routine for so long that our (Body of Christ) desires have not been in alignment to His will. Please don't get me wrong because there are a lot of awesome things happening around the world but the Lord has more in store! We so often say, "OK Lord pour into my old wineskin but remember I like my old wine skin (comfort zone) and I have just broken it in and it is comfortable and you really don't want me to give it up, do you?"

I sat with a pastor in March that travels in the nations and we spoke about the incredible moves of God we experience overseas in many different nations. We had traveled to a few of the same nations. We spoke that in the nations there is an expectation of God to do something.

They come to services hungry and desperate for a move of God. Why are the signs, wonders and miracles we experience in the nations not happening here? We both have seen that the level of expectation of God and desperation for God to do something supernatural is almost nonexistent here in the United States. Many go to church expecting a good worship song, good preaching and released on time. Most people want the new wine (Spirit of God) poured into old wineskins with holes and tears. When the Lord tries to expand the tent ropes the wineskins burst. And there is little to no lasting effects around them.

That was never the design of God for His creation. We were created to expand in our relationship with Him, obligation of relationship with Him, and to carry on the ministry of Christ. Not replace but carry on the ministry of Christ. Not redesign but carry on the ministry of Christ. This cannot be done in old wineskins but has to be new wineskins. What is this wineskin I am talking about? It is the vessel (you) that holds the new wine (His Spirit). When we get to a place of total surrender we see the new wineskin being developed. The more surrender applied the less restrictions exist. The more love for the Lord the stronger the wineskin becomes and the more passion we develop for the Lord the more flexibility (expansion) of the wineskin. With that the Lord will pour out His Greater Glory! Are you ready? Keep making Jesus Famous!

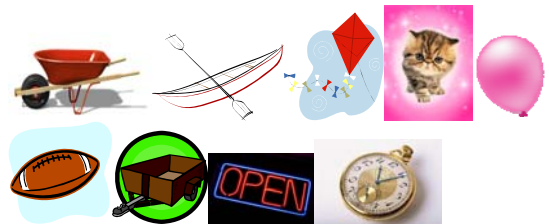
THE FUNNY SIDE OF LIFE – Which kind Are You

The reason for this is because praising Him for His provision will go lacking when we can't see Him providing what we think we need. If we can't see God in our situation, we have difficulty offering praises. Offering praises for what God provides could be called "Provisional Praise." It's not about gaining stuff now. It's about an inheritance that only God can give.

When Satan tempted Jesus in the wilderness, he offered Jesus complete rule over the earthly kingdoms. There was a high price that came with that offer. Jesus would have had to bow down to Satan. That meant that Satan would really be the one in charge of it all. We are offered the same things. Satan will dangle certain temptations out in front of us trying to get us to bite into his lure of complete surrender. We don't have to give into these temptations. We can be just like Jesus when He used the Word of God (submitted to God) turned away from the temptation (resisted the devil) and Satan had to leave Him alone (and he will flee).

It was through the Holy Spirit power of meekness that Jesus overcame the attacks of the enemy. When Jesus was standing before Pilate, accused by the high priest, it was meekness that allowed Him to stand there without saying a word in His own defense. Jesus knew the truth of who He was and their accusations meant nothing to Him. It was meekness that allowed both Jesus and Stephen to ask God to forgive those that were killing them. It was meekness that allowed the apostles the strength to die as martyrs in the face of their enemies.

The world sees meekness as a weakness. With the dog eat dog, winner take all attitude, it's hard not to want to get your share of things. We won't seem to fit in if we appear to refrain from going after the "prize". It is hard for the world to understand that the prize we are going for is far greater than anything outside of Heaven. With that in mind, the church seems to get lost in its purpose because we tend to seek self fulfillment instead of the face of God. We build these elaborate monuments for sanctuaries and think

we've made the big time. We spend a lot of money building up our programs instead of seeking the face of God to see where He wants the money to go. And what does the church have to show for its efforts? 1) A divorce rate that parallels the worlds divorce rate. 2) A body that doesn't know the Word of God. – A lack of true discipleship. 3) A people that are mixed up in things that the Word tells us is not good for us – Harry Potter books and movies and the New Moon movies; just to name a couple of things. The church has to separate itself from the love of this world. The world is getting confused by the mixed signals that we are sending. For that matter, the people inside the church are confused because the elevated leaders of the church are not guiding with a pure light of the Gospel. It's time for the church to get real. We need to get back on our foundation, which is the Word of God, and work to build the kingdom of God first. If we build His kingdom rather than our domain, we can effectively raise up a mighty, spirit filled body of believers that can reach the lost.

Meekness plays an important role in our daily lives. Meekness allows us to surrender our right to getting angry when we are the accused. It's hard not to defend ourselves when we have an accusation brought against us. We tend to let our pride step in and say, "I'll handle this". That's usually when we start getting into trouble. With Jesus being our perfect example, He was able to hold His tongue when faced with impending judgment. His obedience to the Father was much more effective than a long discourse of His innocence. As we can see, the reward of Jesus' obedience is immeasurable. While taking on the ridicule, the pain, the anguish and the weight of all of our sins, Jesus did not lift a hand to stop the crucifixion. **2 Cor. 13:4** states – *"For though He was crucified in weakness, yet He lives by the power of God. For we are also weak in Him, but we shall live with Him by the power of God toward you."*

2 Cor. 12:10 – *Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.* When Stephen was taken before his accusers, he did not spend his last moments defending himself. Stephen preached to the council all that God had done for the nation of Israel, and how they were missing the boat because of the hard hearts toward the Gospel. Stephen was not weak as some would count weakness. He showed great strength in refraining from his own desires to fulfill the desires of God.

Is there anything in this world that we want to inherit anyway? Please understand that persecution will increase. We have to be ready because the world is becoming more intolerant to the things of God. The world is getting into a survivalist mode and the church is standing in the way of the tactics that will be necessary to fulfill its rage. I know that this seems like doom and gloom but let me reassure you in this: When Jesus was asked by the high priest if He was the Christ, the Son of the Blessed (**Mark 14:61**) Jesus replied, *"I am: and you shall see the Son of man sitting*

on the right hand of Power, and coming in the clouds of heaven." (**Mark 14:62**)

Matt. 25:31-34 gives an example of Jesus sitting on His throne as a judge of the nations.

Rev. 19:11 tells us that Jesus will be sitting on a white horse for His second coming. Those examples all declare the awesome majesty of our Lord and Savior, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords, but let me share one more scripture that declares the heart that Jesus has for His saints. **Acts 7:55** – *But he(Stephen), being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up steadfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus **standing** on the right hand of God.* Wow, wow, wow! Jesus was standing up to show honor to His servant Stephen. Jesus sits on His throne in majesty and stands up to honor His saints who take it on the chin for the glory of God. I can imagine Jesus getting really excited and saying, "Look Father, My servant Stephen is being obedient to the very end." Would God reply in this way? "Yes Son, he kind of reminds me of You." Do we remind God of Jesus when we react to situations in our lives? Kind of a tough question to answer at times, isn't it?

How often do we get mad at God because Jesus has not appeared as the kind of Savior we expect Him to be? Just as the Israelites were looking for a savior to deliver them from captivity with a sword and blood thirsty power – so do we. Does God even show up in that awe inspiring “bang” way? Yes, He does! However, it happens when we get out of the way and let Him have his timing and manner of doing things. Yes, there is a savior coming back on a white horse with a sword in his mouth and with a heavenly host, but it is for an appointed time. We need to take our eyes off of who we think God is so we can look around and actually see Him.

If Jesus refused to be conformed to the image of a savior that the world expects him to be, why do we expect our brothers, sisters, parents, pastors and lay leaders be that way? We have the same pattern; things are hard, I messed up, I don't know what to do, HELP! Somebody has to fix this now. Pastor, can do it, brother or sister so and so can do it. The church can do it – be savior on a white horse. And when we find people are not the type of savior/personification of Christ we had created in our minds, we can become angry, resentful and fearful. Our faith in God wavers, our faith in people crumbles, and we start pulling away because of the pain. Then the enemy of our soul feeds this by whispering to our mind, heart and soul. “He doesn't really love you. If he did, he would have rescued you, fixed things, and protected you, given you things.” And so, the fantasy of our savior as a knight or prince on a white horse who will rescue us from the dragon, take us to his fancy castle and shower us with love, gifts, safety and security shatters.

When we don't see God manifest in a quick awe inspiring manner, we tend to become offended, resentful, fearful and angry. Then we take things into our own hands thinking it is God and we are doing what he would have us to do. This usually results in more chaos and disappointment and becomes a downward spiral. One of the ways we can overcome fear is by knowing God's word and believing it. His word tells us that “all things work together for the good for those who loves Him and are called according to his purposes.” Remember- perfect love casts out all fear. His unconditional love for us and our unconditional love for him allows us to operate in faith and trust despite what we see, hear, feel, taste and touch. If we tie in that love with all things working together, then we have to rest in belief. Don't have a job – all things work together; kids are rebelling – all things work together; spouse gone astray – all thing work together; persecution arising on every side – all things work together; can't make the house payment or car payment... - all things work together.

God does do miracles, signs and wonders, but sometimes he lets us work and suffer through things to get our

understanding out of the way. He lets us suffer in order to set us free. He lets us suffer in order to shape and mold us, like the potter molds the clay, **Is. 64:8**. He lets us suffer so that Christ in us overcomes the world in us. He teaches us how to have true dominion over the earth in us; how to till the ground, how to remove the weeds, how to sweat in order to eat of the bread of life (Gen. 3). He teaches us that true trust and submission to God-like love is to be unconditional.

As this process goes on, we become more like our true savior whose “obedience was perfected by the things which He suffered.” God told Paul, “Let Me tell what great things you must suffer.” He tells us, “Who shall be saved? He that endures to the end.” “Count it all joy when you fall into divers temptations, knowing this, that trying of your faith works patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that you may be perfect and entire – wanting nothing” Don't let anyone tell us not to pray for patience. We must have it – it is a fruit of the spirit. Patience helps us to stay in a place to be blessed. It keeps us from trying to fix things ourselves, it stops us from judging others harshly, it helps us to trust God and not expect an instant fix from Him for everything, it allows the time needed for the Holy Spirit to work in us and through us to make us and others truly complete. Patience also protects us from the anti-Christ spirits by causing us to trust and wait in Christ' love. It protects us from being easily deceived by false Christ's who come to deceive. (Satan disguised as an angel of light.) Through patience Christ's love is given the necessary time needed to bring us and others to His perfection. In the Greek, perfection comes from the root word *teleios*; it means to be finished, complete and mature. Suffering often helps to bring us to completion and maturity.

We need to stop letting situations and circumstances lock us into a period of time or a state of confusion. Let's take a look back and see how far He has brought us and others. Look to the present and know he is in the midst. Look forward to the future and the hope of it – knowing with joy that He is not finished. He gives us a hope and a future, but we have to be prepared for it. If He immediately poured in everything He has stored up for us in the future, we would crumble. We, as His vessels, have to be tempered and prepared first. Our Lord is indeed strong and handsome, beautiful and fair, powerful and gentle. He came as the Prince of Peace and He is now returning as the King of Kings and Lord of Lords on a white horse. But, when things don't go as expected, we need to stop running around in panic mode which so often leads us away from God's plan. Instead, we need to run to Him for the directions to carry out His divine plan. As we do – He will meet us and complete us! Praise God!
