The Weapons of Our Warfare- A series on our spiritual weapons -

Worship Bv: Patrick Bucksot

Worship. This is probably the hardest of the weapons to define. Why? So far, we have discussed the Word of God, the Name of Jesus, Obedience, Faith, Love, Forgiveness, Prayer, Fasting, and Praise. You would have a hard time convincing me that I have not already been writing about worship. Every one of these weapons and the upcoming weapons are a form of worship to God. Every one of them is required to worship our Father in Heaven.

Worship is not isolated to singing a few songs on Sunday morning. Worship is an attitude. It is an attitude of submission to God. Yet, it cannot be simply defined as submission. Submission to God is only a form of worship. It is, however, one of the main ingredients. You could also define it as "Face Time with God". God desires that we worship Him. In the Old Testament, the Hebrews became more about where they worshiped than who they worshiped. But, in their defense, they worshiped. At every victorious milestone, they would build a pillar that represented the twelve tribes of Israel and would worship God. They would also name the place to represent how God had provided the victory. I believe that this is one thing that we as believers sincerely fall short in worship of God. We do not chart the times of victorious moments with God. Why would this be important? As I stated in last month's newsletter, offering praise (building a pillar) to God acts as a catalyst for your own faith, but also the faith of others. It is a marker for others to see that God is still working on our

behalf. As we build those pillars, we need to remember them because there may be a time in the desert when we cannot see God working. If we can walk by the pillar and remember what God had done, it will be much easier to continue our walk.

As I stated earlier, worship is an attitude. When we see that someone has an attitude, we usually think that they have a problem. But, if we do not have an attitude of worship we have a serious problem. When we go to church on Sunday, what is our attitude or motivation? Are we going there to socialize or are we going there to worship God. Are we going there because we think that it is our obligation to the church? Or, are we going there because we love God? When we get there, do we not sing because we don't like the music? Or do we sing whether we know the songs or not. Do we listen to the message or ignore the pastor because we are bored? The questions being asked are pointed in opposite directions. One direction is pointed at us and the other is pointed toward God. If our answers point to us, we will never be satisfied in any area of our lives. If our answers point toward God and pleasing Him, He will satisfy in the way that Jesus explained to the Samaritan woman. He said in **John 4:14**, "*but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life.*" When we worship God, only He can satisfy our soul.

Pastors Corner- A word from Pastor Ron – “A CALL TO FASTING”

It is a great journey when we are seeking the face of the Father. I am enjoying the walk closer to God. He has been drawing me deeper and deeper in our relationship as well as deeper in the relationships around me. I have peeled things out of my life that was holding me back from getting closer to Him and in that He has been drawing me deeper into His arms. It is so awesome to know that His perfect love is overshadowing my imperfect life. He just loves us because He loves us because that is just what He does. God is so cool! He is so awesome!

One of the most powerful tools the Lord gives us as believers is stolen. We have allowed the enemy to steal the tool that not only draws us closer to God but empowers us with His wisdom, boldness, supernatural faith and results. What I am talking about is Fasting. Yes I did say that word, “*Fasting*”. Sadly the moment the word Fasting is spoken there is an immediate response to find excuses or reasons that we can’t fast or ways to do something else and call it fasting when in fact it is not fasting.

I have been hearing and hearing the Lord say, “Call My people to Fast and Pray!” We are at a place right now in our churches, communities, state, nation and even around the world that the people of God need to get on our faces to fast and pray.

In my time with the Lord these last seven months He has been putting on me the urgency to draw closer and to prepare to move from private fast to a more powerful place; a place that will bring His people closer to Him and empower them to do the next level of ministry. So I have been seeking the timing of the Lord and the time is now!

I am calling a “Corporate Fast” every Wednesday at the Breath of God International Outreach Church and to all that fellowship with us around the world. I have started contacting ministries and churches around the world and have asked them to join us every Wednesday for a fast and prayer.

And there is more, the Lord placed deep in my heart to go the extra mile so we are calling it “*FAST FOOD WEDNESDAY’S*”. Place a Jar or container around the place you have your meals and every Wednesday place in that jar or container the amount you would have spent on the meals you fast on Wednesday’s. Get the family involved,

share with friends, neighbors, coworkers, everyone the Lord puts on your heart. On the last Sunday each month bring your Fast Food Wednesday money and we will as a corporate body unite together and put the money in a large container at church. The “*FAST FOOD WEDNESDAYS FUNDS*” will go to a food program to feed people in need.

Why is this so important? Why should I be uncomfortable and fast? In the book of Mark 9:14-29 a father, desperate to have his little boy healed, heard about how God was using the disciples of Jesus to heal the sick. He grabbed his son and went to the disciples. But, when they tried to heal the boy nothing happened and the crowd got mad. The father started losing his faith then Jesus showed up. The father came up to Jesus as He asked what was going on. When the father told the story he ended it with a remarkable statement, “*If you can heal him.*” The fathers’ faith was affected by the lack of the disciples’ ability. Jesus healed the father’s faith first then the little boy. After Jesus healed the boy and they left along with the crowd the disciples asked Jesus why they could not heal the boy. Jesus spoke a powerful response to their question. He said, “*This comes only by prayer and fasting.*” WOW!

Fear of not knowing the proper way to fast and the past failures has allowed the enemy to steal the power of prayer and fasting from the Body of Christ! Is it not time to take back what has been stolen? Is it not time to put the enemy back in his place under your feet? Then be a part of this awesome journey with God we are embarking upon.

I will be teaching on Fasting in the next several weeks both on Sunday mornings and Thursday nights. I also have available an 11 page directions to successful fasting if you would like to get a copy. I believe this will draw us closer to the Father and empower us more with His awesome Anointing! Let’s give an invitation for an invasion and watch God rip open heaven and pour His wonderful Love and Glory out!

Start now by praying and asking the Lord to help you. Seek the right attitude of fasting and the excitement of getting closer to the Father. Remember that the Lord honors those that seek His face and His heart. Keep making Jesus Famous!

Ministry Spotlight – Mission Trip to India

The Lord is opening doors at Breath of God International Outreach Ministries. For example, on previous Breath of God International Outreach mission trips in 2000 - 2009 to Nigeria, West Africa, South Africa, Uganda, Swaziland, Kenya, Argentina, Chile, and the Ukraine over 250,000 people gave their lives to Jesus. In addition, money was provided for Bible and Christian Literature translation; over 2500 Bibles were handed out to new Christians; expenses were paid so that two children could be placed in an orphanage for two years; food and clothing were distributed to those in need; supplies were purchased for pastors and churches; salary was provided for 11 pastors for an entire year; two churches were each provided with a roof; an orphanage was close to completion; musical instruments were provided for several churches; "praise & worship" was led and experienced; medication was provided for a pastor's pregnant wife; burial was provided for a mother of a pastor; and funds were given to provide medication and hospitalization for a man involved in an automobile accident. Breath of God International Outreach Ministries provided education for treatment, awareness and prevention of AIDS. Conferences for leadership, youth, pastors, and others were held to enhance ministries in the nations. Homeless street kids were ministered to and fed along with churches being shown how to minister to them after we left.

Breath of God International Outreach Ministries has the awesome opportunity of sending a ministry team to Hyderabad, India in September. We are making preparations by having regular meetings to discuss various factors about the trip. Pastor Ron is sharing insights with us from his previous missionary trips to various countries. We are also praying for God's provision concerning the trip. His provision is not only for the financial needs, but that the fields are ready for the harvest. We are expecting God to do great things on this trip.

The ministry team will be headed up by

Pastor Ron Estes and include Boyd and Jane Stokes, Gary and Telia Galloway and Patrick Bucksot. We will be leaving on September 2nd with a return date of Sept. 12th. It has been planned for us to speak at a Pastors Conference, Prayer Conference, Church Leadership Conference, an open air crusade, 12 different churches and a Pastors Wives' Conference. As you can see, this is not a sightseeing journey. We will be very busy for the Lord.

Pastor Ron, Boyd and Patrick will be sharing God's word for most events while Jane and Telia will be speaking to the Pastors' wives. Telia will be sharing in special music for most of the events. Everyone will be in prayer while someone is in active ministry time. The prayer ministry during the trip is just as important as the Word of God being spoken during a conference. The individual speakers need to be saturated in prayer before, during and after their time of ministry.

This is where you, the body of Christ comes in. We need to be active in prayer over this ministry team. When you fast and pray on "Fast Foods Wednesdays", the India trip and ministry team would be a good subject to pray about. This team desires for nothing more than God to be glorified in all that we do, say, think and who we are. We want those in India to know that God visited them in a powerful way. Our families are also in need of much prayer and support while we are gone. The burden of taking on all that we do at home will be theirs completely. They need the peace of God that passes all understanding because a deep concern for our safety can be heavy at times. You also need to pray for the nation of India to be ready for a powerful move of God.

We look forward to our return to testify of God's greatness, His love and mercy, the awesome ways that He proved Himself to the people of India.

As we enter into an attitude of worship, it will infiltrate every part of our lives. When things are going very well for us, worship is easy. When life starts getting tough, so does worship. But in order for worship to be a true weapon of our warfare, we need to think of worship in this manner. When the busyness of life makes it difficult to press through in worship of God, worship needs to become our WAR SHIP. Our military has several ships of war including, the destroyer, air craft carrier, the battleship and the submarine. Each vessel has its own purpose and type of missions, but each one fights for a common goal: DESTROY THE WORKS OF THE ENEMY. When we see the need to worship God, there is usually a specific thing that tugs at our hearts. It could be personal, or it could be for the needs of others. None the less, our worship to God will put us into battle with our enemy, who is the Devil. The person that cut us off in traffic, our friend who offended us, the person who skipped in line at the bank; they are not our enemy. It is up to us to bring our flesh into subjection and worship God. This could be done in the form of forgiving someone, praying for someone, giving food to someone, or giving someone a ride to the store. These acts of worship to God show people that they are important and God has an exalted place in our lives.

When Jesus was tempted in the wilderness He used the Word of God to overcome the enemy. He was worshiping God. When Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego and Daniel refused to bow to someone or something other than God, they were worshiping God. Their worship became a war ship, captained by God Himself that destroyed the work of the enemy. When Beth and I refused to allow a premature delivery to destroy our hope for a family, our relationship with each other, and our faith in the Lord, our worship of God carried us through the difficult times. The victory of that time has become a pillar for us, and we use it often to minister to others. God has done tremendous things for us and through us since the premature delivery. Has the pain of the loss left us completely? No. But, when we see God use us and the premature delivery to minister to others for His kingdom's sake, we are able to rejoice. We are able to be comforted by His Holy Spirit and know that this event in our lives did not happen in vain.

When tragedy strikes, worship God and see where He takes you. When you can get beyond your own hurt and worship God, He will multiply blessings beyond your wildest dreams. Paul and Silas could not have imagined that their beatings and jail time would lead a man and his family to a saving knowledge of God through Jesus Christ.

Jesus said in **John 4:20-24** that worship is not about a certain place to worship God but a place from which we worship God. He said in **verse 24**: *"God is a spirit, and those that worship Him must worship him in spirit and in truth."* This true worship comes from deep within the heart of man. It does not matter where you are physically. You could put it this way, it does not matter what state you are in but the state that your heart is in. One is a location and the other in attitude. Most that read this newsletter live in North Carolina, but the state or attitude of our heart is toward heavenly things. True worship allows us to get beyond ourselves and everything around us. At this point, we can focus totally on the Lord. When we go to church on Sunday, can we forget that there is a multitude surrounding us? Can we focus our hearts on the Lord as if no one else is watching? Can we sing to the Lord as if no one else will hear us? Can we dance before the Lord as if no one else is around? Sadly, most of us would have to say no. Me included. Worship is one on one with God. It does not seek attention. It does not seek any glory that is due to God alone. Worship is not puffed up. Worship is first selfless to God and His kingdom desires. Worship desires to exhort others into a closer relationship to God.

One very special note about worship; God will not share our worship with anyone or anything. God is jealous of our worship. He will not intrude on our free will, but has made it clear that He desires us to be clean before Him. He desires for us to fellowship with Him. Thus the reason that the veil was torn in two. We have been made worthy to enter His presence by His own Son Jesus. Always remember, when we get into worshiping other people or things, they will be changing their rules every day. God is the same yesterday, today and forever. Serving God is much easier than serving others. True worship is being a true servant of God. His rules do not change because He does not change.
