Testimony By: Patrick Bucksot

Imagine yourself in a court of law as the accused. You are waiting for the first witness to be sworn in and begin to answer the attorneys' questions. You are nervous because you have no idea what this particular witness did or did not see. You believe that your attorney had built a pretty solid case for your defense, but you don't know what information the prosecuting attorney has. You are at the mercy of the court. The witness has been sworn in and has been asked the first question. You can hardly breathe. The prosecuting attorney asks the witness, "What did you see on the night of the crime?" "I saw that man commit the crime in question." Wow, eye witness testimony against you. It can be very condemning. Your life hangs in the balance with every word. It is a powerful tool used by the court system to make sure that the accused are either put behind bars or set free if the evidence does not match the testimony.

Our testimony is not just powerful in a court of law. It is a powerful weapon of our warfare. We are to use our testimony to speak of the many good things that God has done to bring victory in our lives. It is a way of sharing the gospel of Jesus. It may be the one thing that helps someone to believe in Jesus.

The problem with most believers today is this, we have gotten used to having everything come to us quickly. We have a hard time waiting two minutes for the microwave to warm up the left over's. We can't sit at a traffic light without grumbling. We hate it when we have a 1:00 PM doctor's appointment and we are still in the

waiting room at 1:30. All of these situations allow us the opportunity to tell the world about our problems. This has become our testimony. I have heard stories about friends of complainers who hide behind things to avoid being seen by the complainers. They know that if they are seen, they will be there for a long time, listening to their problems. You would think that the word testimony was pronounced "test and moaning".

It is true that there are a lot of problems in this world. We do have bad days. We do have financial problems. We do have arguments with our friends. And, it is hard not to complain about them. We must, however, remember the testimony of God:

Due. 28:13: *And the LORD will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you today, and are careful to observe [them].*

Due. 33:12: *"The beloved of the LORD shall dwell in safety by Him, [Who] shelters him all the day long; And he shall dwell between His shoulders."*

Psalm 57:3: *He shall send from heaven and save me; He reproaches the one who would swallow me up. Selah God shall send forth His mercy and His truth.*

John 15:16: *You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and [that] your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.*

Ministry Spotlight – World Wide Church Without Walls

There is a ministry located in New Bern, NC that does not have four walls to call its own. As a matter of fact, the ministries name states that it does not have any walls. The ministry is called World Wide Church Without Walls. The greatest thing about this ministry is that it incorporates people from different churches and crosses denominational lines to proclaim Jesus Christ to a lost and dying world. WWCWW is breaking the mold of what traditional ministry has been.

This team, headed by our very own Fran Giummule, utilizes skits/dramas, preaching, testimony, puppets, dance, music and games to reach communities surrounding the New Bern area. They have traveled to Wallace, Kinston and Goldsboro to reach the lost.

WWCWW has trained other church groups from Wallace, Kinston and Goldsboro to move out to take their communities back with evangelism. Ministry is a team effort. The New Bern WWCWW cannot be everywhere, and by training other churches for street evangelism, it broadens the effective ministry of WWCWW.

WWCWW will minister in the local church but prefers to be in the streets. Their hearts are for those outside of the local church. They desire to reach people for Christ and get them plugged into a local body of believers in their own community.

In August, Church Without Walls was able to minister at the National Night Out event in Union Point Park located on the New Bern water front. This event is a one night event to bring the community together and come out against crime and drugs. National Night Out is an awesome opportunity for a ministry like WWCWW to share the love of Jesus.

Every year at Christmas, WWCWW ministers at the Country Biscuit in New Bern. Those in attendance are blessed by the Word of God from the team. After the ministry time, the team feeds anyone that has attended. WWCWW also gives gifts to the children and adults.

As with any ministry, Church Without Walls works with a Passion for Christ and compassion for the lost. It is a desire of this ministry to touch the hurt of someone's heart with the Gospel of Christ. Jesus is the only real hope in a world that offers many paths toward God. Jesus said in John 12:32, "And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all [men] unto me." THE FUNNY SIDE OF LIFE - A QUESTION OF OWNERSHIP

Some years ago a New Orleans lawyer sought a direct Veterans Administration loan for a client. He was told that the loan would be approved if he could provide proof of clear title to the property offered as collateral. The title for the property in question was complicated, and he spent a considerable amount of time reviewing all pertinent documents back to 1803. Satisfied with the depth and expanse of his examination, he submitted the information to the V.A. He soon received this reply from the V.A.: "We received your letter today enclosing application for a loan for your client, supported by abstract of title. The application forms are complete, but you have not cleared the title before the year 1803. Therefore, before full review and possible approval can be accorded the application, it will be necessary that the title be cleared back before that year." Annoyed, the lawyer wrote the V.A.:

"Your letter regarding titles in case #9378329 received. I note that you wish titles extended further back than I have presented. Your attention is invited to the following information to update your records for the property prior to 1803:

a) I was unaware that any educated person would not know that the United States gained clear title to Louisiana from France in 1803. This title transfer was a result of a real estate transaction known as The Louisiana Purchase. b) France gained clear title to Louisiana by right of conquest from Spain under the Treaty of San Ildefonso (1800). c) The land came into the possession of Spain by right of discovery in 1492 by a sailor named Christopher Columbus. He was acting on behalf of Isabella, Queen of Spain, and had her permission to claim newly discovered lands for Spain. d) The good Queen, being a pious woman and careful about titles -- almost as careful as the V.A. -- took the precaution of securing the blessing of the Pope before authorizing the voyage. e) The Pope is a servant of God; God created the world. f) Therefore, I believe that it is safe to presume that God created title to that part of the world called Louisiana and thus was the original holder of the property in question."

2 Cor. 6:18: *"I will be a Father to you, And you shall be My sons and daughters, Says the LORD Almighty."*

I know that I barely scratched the surface with scriptures of what God thinks of us, but I think that you should get the point. God's word is just as powerful in these scriptures as in Genesis, when He created everything. His passion for us has never diminished, and it will never end. His testimony over us is love, grace, mercy, tenderness and all good things. When we struggle though, we blame God for our circumstance. Is it His fault? Examine your situation. Have you walked out from under His covering? He is a strong tower to which we should be running. We can take comfort under the shadow of his wings. With Him, there is protection.

It is very important that our testimony match that of our Father. We should always remind ourselves of who we are in Him. Pastor Ron said this a few weeks ago; "Jesus died on the cross for you, how bad can it really be?"

Isaiah 54:17 says *No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue [which] rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This [is] the heritage of the servants of the LORD, And their righteousness [is] from Me," Says the LORD*

It says that there is not a weapon formed that can destroy you. It also says that you will condemn every tongue that tries to bring judgment against you. The only stipulation to this is staying under the covering of God.

Billy Graham is an excellent example of this. If a woman tried to accuse him of sexual harassment, he could rest under the shadow of God's wings. Why? Billy Graham would not place himself in a situation where he would be alone with a woman. He refused to open that door of temptation. If he was waiting for an elevator and a woman was on there alone, he would let it go and wait for the next one. He did not want his testimony for God to be damaged by his carelessness. He also did not want his flesh to be tempted. God has honored the ministry of Billy Graham because of his faithfulness.

Before Jesus was put on trial, Peter said that he would never deny Him. He said that he would die for Jesus. That was a pretty powerful testimony. But when the test came, he did a lot of moaning. He refused to tell the truth. He said that he did not know

Jesus. When the rooster crowed in the morning, Peter recalled his conversation with Jesus and was ashamed. That is how powerful our testimonies are. **Prov. 18:21** says, *"Death and life [are] in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit."*

If you love the words of death, you will eat of its fruit. If you love the words of life, you will eat of its fruit. We all need to train ourselves to speak life. Unfortunately, we live in a time when a man's word or testimony doesn't really mean anything. There used to be a time when a contract was sealed with your word (or testimony) and a hand shake. It was a time when a man could be counted on to do what he said he would do. Your word WAS your testimony. The spoken word is probably the most powerful tool that God has given us. As stated in the scripture above, our words send either life or death.

Let's go back to the court room. The prosecuting attorney has brought about some pretty powerful evidence against you. The testimony of his witness was very convincing to the jury. The judge himself could not deny the facts set before him, yet he had to await the verdict of the jury. As the jury deliberates, you agonize about the outcome. You know that things are not looking good but your attorney has an excellent record in this court room. When the jury finally arrives and pronounces their verdict of "Guilty on all counts." The prosecutors are elated and you are sobbing. The court room erupts with a lot of commotion. The judge orders everyone to be quiet as your attorney approaches the bench. After a few moments with the judge, the prosecuting attorney protests the judge's order to release you. He pronounces that your advocate has taken your place, and it is His testimony about His love for you that has made you free. If you know the truth (**John 14:6**), and He will make you free. **Rev. 12:11;** *And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.* The blood of the lamb has already paid the price for your freedom, but your testimony will keep you free. Your testimony brings victory if the Word of God is the fountain from which it comes.
